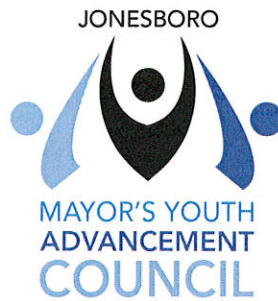

 - Scooter's to downtown

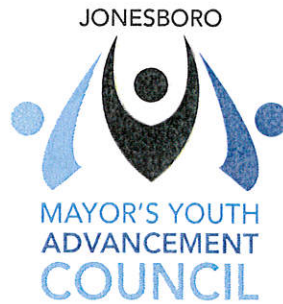
