

Chairman Johns Street asked if Planning Director Derrell Smith was present, and if so would he speak on this ordinance.

Planning Director Derrell Smith explained that sometime between when the current code came out, and in between the old code and what we are dealing with now in C2 which, is the down town fringe commercial uses is to allow residential. When they copied the old code into the new code they showed that residential was still allowed in the schedule of uses, they took it out of there, but it showed it in the lot area requirements. So, if you look you will see that C2 has lot size, lot set-back, and density, all of that is included. When you go into the residential portion it doesn't show that it is allowed. It appears to me that when they did that, they were cutting and pasting, and failed to put it into the schedule and uses portion of the document.

Planning Director Derrell Smith continued to explain that by definition down town fringe

is a mix of uses, and you would think that by definition that residential would be allowed. We did hold out the C2 of what they call the hotel corridor zone that is out along I-555, there is a strip of C2 on both sides where the hotels are. So, we did not allow the residential in that. The areas around down town where we still have C2 zoning, which is where we want to still include residential. Chairman John Street said, 'okay and thank you Sir". Chairman Street ask if there was any more questions regarding this.

Councilmember LJ Bryant commented that he has worked a little bit with Planning Director Derrell Smith on this. I think it is a really good and important issue, it seems like that it was just a technicality problem. I think if you look at what Heather Clark and others have done on Huntington, which I think is C1, but just a couple of lots down from there it is C2, and then like Krewson, which buts up against the Cavanaugh property. A lot of that property is prime for redevelopment. Councilmember Bryant explained that until we fix this I don't see that anyone can do anything with those tiny lots. Core projects will be able to be done if we fix this.

Chairman John Street asked Deputy April Leggett to show Councilmember Chris Moore present in the meeting. Deputy Clerk Leggett said "yes sir". Chairman Street asked if there were any more comments. Mayor Harold Perrin said, one thing we need to do is allow 35 to 40 seconds for the public to call in or make comments since this is a virtual meeting. Chairman John Street asked Deputy Clerk April Leggett to please be the time keeper of that.

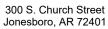

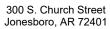

This proposal does not include construction administration, construction inspection services, lighting and electrical plans, and geotechnical services. However, Fisher Arnold can provide these services at your request if needed.

We will bill you monthly or upon completion of the project. Payment is due by the 15th of the month. Payment of the fees is not contingent on transaction of the property, closing dates relating to the property, approval of plans related to the property by any governmental agency or payment received from another party. Interest in the amount of 1.5% per month on the outstanding balances (18% per annum) will be assessed the contracting party after the payment due date.

Reimbursables will be billed at cost plus 15% and include, but not limited to the following: Courthouse & Research Fees, Filing, Copies, Prints, Utility Location by Others, Postage and Shipping, etc.

In the event of breach or non-payment, the contracting party agrees to pay reasonable expenses of enforcement including attorney fees and costs. Exclusive venue for enforcement of this Agreement shall be in Craighead County, Arkansas.

The obligation to provide further services under the Agreement may be terminated by either party upon written notice in the event of substantial failure by the other party to perform in accordance with the terms hereof through no fault of the terminating party.

In the event of termination, Fisher & Arnold, Inc. will be paid for all services rendered to the date of termination and all reimbursable expenses.

The fees shown in this proposal are based on the Owner agreeing to limit the Professional's liability for all planning, engineering and surveying services to the Owner, all construction contractors, and subcontractors on the project, due to the Professional's negligent acts, errors or omissions, such that the total aggregate liability of the Professional to all those named shall not exceed the Professional's total fee for services rendered on the project.

This proposal represents the entire understanding between you and us in respect to the "Project" and may only be modified in writing signed by both of us.
