WHEREAS, the CDBG funds are 100% federally funded and local match is not required; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Program funds shall be used for infrastructure projects, public facility and improvements, homeownership assistance, homeowner rehabilitation assistance, demolition and clearance assistance, homelessness activities, public services, and program administration; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG-CV funds shall be used for support to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the Coronavirus pandemic as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (CARES Act); and

WHEREAS, the 2020 Annual Action Plan was passed and approved through RES-20:060 by the City Council on June 9, 2020.



SECTION 2. The respective funds for each item of expenditure proposed in the budget for 2020 are hereby approved and adopted for the operation of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, by the City Council on this date and constitute an appropriation of funds which are lawfully applicable to the items contained within the budget. This budget may be altered or revised by action of this governing body and unpledged funds may be subsequently appropriated to another purpose except as prohibited by law. A.C.A. § 14-58-203(a).

SECTION 3. The Mayor or his duly-authorized representative may approve for payment, out of funds appropriated by this budget or otherwise approved by the city council for those purposes, or may disapprove any bills, debts, or liabilities asserted as claims against the City. Provided, however, that the execution of all contracts and conveyances and lease contracts shall be performed by the Mayor and City Clerk, when authorized by a resolution in writing and approved by a majority vote of the city council present and participating.

SECTION 4. If any provision of this resolution or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of the resolution which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this resolution are declared to be severable.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE AND ACCEPT THE 2020 COPS HIRING GRANT WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro was awarded the 2020 COPS Hiring Grant in the amount of \$618,158 with a local match requirement of \$206,053 for a total award of \$824,211; and

WHEREAS, the FY2020 COPS Hiring Program award provides funding to law enforcement agencies to hire career law enforcement officers in an effort to increase community policing capacity and crime prevention efforts; and

WHEREAS, this grant will fund 5 new officer positions (salaries and benefits) at 75% by the U.S. Department of Justice and a 25% local match during the first three years and 100% local funds for the fourth year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas passed the 2020 Budget in Resolution RES-19:201, which will need to be amended in order to reflect the award amount's local match.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Jonesboro will enter into agreement with the Department of Justice to accept the 2020 COPS Hiring Grant for \$617,158 for five officers for a three year period; and

SECTION 2: The 2020 budget is hereby amended to provide a change in the Federal Funds budget for the COPS Hiring Program to account for the amount of local match needed for the balance of the year, wherein the remaining local match will be included in future budget requests; and

SECTION 3: The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized by the City Council for the City of Jonesboro to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this application.

The Department of Justice 2020 COPS Hiring Program

The City of Jonesboro was awarded the COPS Hiring Program grant to hire five new officers for 3 years with a 1-year post grant retention*. This will allow us to increase patrol in high crime areas and provide much needed community policing. We have a 2% increase in population which has caused an increase in crime and traffic violations.
