Councilmember Charles Frierson said, it lists that this \$100,000 is to be for homelessness prevention. Does that limit us in any way? City Attorney Carol Duncan asked if Community Development Director Regina Burkett had logged into the ZOOM meeting. Deputy Clerk April Leggett said, no. Attorney Duncan stated that she did not know the answer to the question asked by Councilmember Frierson. Councilmember David McClain said, my question is similar to Councilmember Frierson's or is this going toward somebody who's in the process of being removed from a home because they lost a job, what does that look like? Councilmember Chris Gibson said in my eyes that would be homelessness prevention.

Chairman Mitch Johnson asked City Attorney Carol Duncan if she had a copy of the letter and what her thoughts were. City Attorney Carol Duncan said that that may be what they mean by it. Obviously if you are helping with rental assistance, you are preventing someone from becoming homeless. I would need to ask Regina Burkett, Director of Community Development to see the actual grant application. My thought is those could mean the same thing. It does say rental assistance under homelessness prevention. Councilmember Frierson said, I am certainly for it, I just wondered if we were held down to less than what we thought. Councilmember Gene Vance said, we have restrictions on every one of those grants, and if we don't get it somebody else will.

Patti Lack, 4108 Forrest Hill Road. I just wanted to say that Regina Burkett, Director of Community Development is doing a wonderful job finding grants for Jonesboro. She works hard looking for grants to help our city. I think this is a really good grant that has come up.

Community Development Director Regina Burkett explained that there were several different category's for the grant. We applied for the rental assistance and it goes along with homelessness. I have called them to ask them about building a homeless shelter with some of this money. They told me it could not be used for that. I also asked them if we could do temporary shelter, like hotel rentals and they said, no that we could not do that either, because we do not have a shelter for homelessness. So, that is why we just decided to do the rental assistance program.

### AN ORDINANCE TO PLACE VARIOUS TRAFFIC SIGNS AT DESIGNATED LOCATIONS AS RECOMMENDED BY THE TRAFFIC CONTROL COMMITTEE NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS to make the following changes as recommended by the Traffic Control Committee:

Section 1: Establish a 20 MPH speed limit at the following locations: Medical Drive.

Section 2: Establish a 25 MPH speed limit at the following locations: Wilmar Circle
June Drive
Forest Hill Road
Raider Road
Parker Annex Road
Sierra Court
Willow Pointe Subdivision - Phase IV
Edgemont Park Subdivision - All Phases
Bridlewood Phase - Phase IV and All Future Phases
Paula Drive - All Sections

Section 3: Establish a 30 MPH speed limit at the following location: Latourette Drive - All Sections.

Section 4: Change the speed limit from 20 MPH to 25 MPH at the following locations: Dupwe Drive - All Sections.

Section 5: Install stop signs at the following locations: Southbound Willow Pointe Court @ Willow Ridge Drive Stopping Edgemont Drive at Old Paragould Drive Stopping Glitterman Drive at Long Crest Drive Stopping Glitterman Drive at Saddlecrest Drive Stopping Medical Drive at Old Bridger
