City Water & Light and the City of Jonesboro have determined that there is a mutual operational benefit for both parties to construct a 196' freestanding communications tower at 2410 Greensboro Road. The property is currently owned by City Water & Light and houses a large water tank, which serves the citizens of Jonesboro. This project has been cleared by FAA in regard to airport flight patterns with the stipulation the tower will have the appropriate day and nighttime warning lights. The tower will be utilized for a backup Emergency Radio Service TRBO trunking communications system for City emergency operations and City Water and Light. The topographical qualities of this property make it an ideal site to locate a tower of this nature. Even though the sites' current use is commercial in nature it has been zoned R-1 since annexation.
