

#### Homeowner Rehabilitation Assistance Program

#### JONESBORO, AR

Whether elderly, disabled, or living on a fixed income, low-to moderate-income homeowners in Jonesboro, Arkansas can apply for grants to make necessary home repairs and improvements. The Jonesboro Homeowner Rehabilitation Assistance Program not only helps to provide safe, healthy living conditions for those in need. but improves the overall quality of housing in the community. Since 2016, the program has helped 15 homeowners make critical housing repairs, including roof installations, replacement of heating or cooling units, and replacement of broken windows and doors. The City of Jonesboro was able to use \$175,000 in Community Development Block Grant funding to help homeowners make critical repairs that they otherwise wouldn't be able to afford.
