



Description

The interior is an open space with an office in the southeast corner and a bathroom and storage area in the northwest corner. Standalone shelves will be built and secured to the interior walls to display items. The floor space will also have shelving, displays or larger sale items organized throughout. A pony wall will be built on the northwest corner of the building to separate the items for sale from the donated items being processed (in-take). Cabinets will be installed near the main entrance as a register/checkout area. The covered porch area will display larger and heavier items that can be outside such as tile, appliances, building material, and other items. The building has three standard doors and four overhead doors. Habitat plans to only use one of the overhead door to bring in donated items and one standard door as the entrance. The other standard door will be used only when necessary.
