  It is a part of an existing parcel owned by Highland Kathleen, LLC that has multiple zonings. The rezoning is necessary in order to achieve a single parcel with one zoning.

  As an expansion of Williams Equipment which lies to the East of the site.

This parcel will add 12,043 sq. ft. of area for the future expansion of Williams Equipment.

  The property would be used to support the economic growth of the City of Jonesboro.
