LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS LEASE AGREEMENT (the "Lease") is entered into by and between **HUNTINGTON STATION FT LLC**, an Arkansas limited liability company, its successor and assigns ("Landlord"), and **GRILLZIL**, **LLC**, an Arkansas limited liability company ("Tenant"), and **ROJO's ON HUNTINGTON**, **INC**., an Arkansas Non-Profit Corporation ("Tenant").

1. Definitions.

- a. *Premises*. The Premises means that certain pad to be leased by Tenant (the "Premises"), as located on that certain lot with a street address of 601 West Huntington Avenue, Jonesboro, Craighead County, Arkansas 72401 (the "Development"), with such pad as depicted on <u>Exhibit A</u> attached hereto. Landlord and Tenant acknowledge there shall be a total of five (5) mobile food vendors and one (1) bar/beverage vendor located within the Development.
- b. Term. The Lease Term shall commence on or about May 1, 2021 and shall end on such date that is sixty (60) months from the Rent Commencement Date. The "Rent Commencement Date" shall be such date that is the earlier of: (i) the date Tenant completes improvements on the Premises and obtains a certificate of occupancy from the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas; or (ii) May 1, 2021. In the event Tenant holds over after expiration of the Term, the Base Rent shall increase to one hundred twenty five percent (125%) of the pre-termination rate, and Landlord may pursue any remedies to remove Tenant from the Premises.
- c. *Rent*. The Base Rent shall be due and payable to Landlord in advance on the first day of each month at Landlord's place of business or such other place as Landlord may designate. Monthly Base Rent shall be Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 United States Dollars (\$950.00) per month. Any other sums due to Landlord from Tenant as set forth herein shall be deemed "Additional Rent" (Base Rent and Additional Rent shall be collectively referred to herein as "Rent").
- d. Security Deposit. Tenant shall deposit with Landlord the sum of Nine Hundred Fifty and No/100 United States Dollars (\$950.00) as a security deposit (the "Deposit"), with the Deposit to be paid upon execution of this Lease by both parties. The Deposit shall be held by Landlord, without liability for or payment of interest thereon, as security for the faithful performance by Tenant of all the terms, covenants and conditions of this Lease by Tenant to be performed. Landlord shall have no obligation to hold the Deposit in a separate fund. If at any time during the Term any Rent payable by Tenant shall be overdue, or if Tenant fails to perform any of the other terms, covenants or conditions to be performed by Tenant, then Landlord at its option, may appropriate and apply all or any portion of the Deposit to the payment of any such overdue Rent and to the compensation of Landlord for loss or damage sustained by Landlord due to a breach by Tenant as aforesaid, without prejudice to Landlord's other remedies.
- 2. <u>Lease</u>. For the duration of the Term, Landlord hereby leases to Tenant and Tenant hereby accepts the Premises for the exclusive purpose of using the Premises to operate Tenant's mobile food vending business. During the Term and so long as Tenant is in full compliance with all terms and conditions of this Lease, Landlord covenants that Tenant shall have the exclusive right to operate a food truck/trailer selling non-alcoholic beverages and alcoholic beverages (Inside Bar) on the Premises. Landlord shall be solely responsible for providing picnic or dining tables for all mobile food vending businesses located at the Development, access by Tenant to the grease trap location within the Development, and access by Tenant and Tenant's patrons to the common restrooms for the benefit of the Development. Tenant shall return the Premises to Landlord at the end of the Term in the same condition as the Premises is delivered to Tenant subject to reasonable wear and tear; provided, any improvements to the Premises (other than the food truck/trailer and any trade fixtures that can be removed without

materially damaging the Premises) shall be considered a permanent part of the Premises and shall belong to Landlord. Notwithstanding the foregoing, any property, fixtures, food trucks/trailers, etc. left on the Premises after the termination date shall automatically and irrevocably be deemed abandoned and shall become the exclusive property of Landlord with Landlord having the right to keep or remove the abandoned property at Tenant's expense. Tenant shall not assign this Lease or sublet all or any part of the Premises without the prior written consent of the Landlord, which consent may be withheld in Landlord's absolute discretion. Landlord shall have the right to assign this Leases to any person or entity, without necessity of consent by, or notice to, Tenant. Any approved assignment or sublet by Tenant shall not relieve Tenant of any obligations under the Lease.

- 3. Maintenance and Repair. Tenant acknowledges it has inspected the Premises and accepts the Premises in "AS IS" condition. Notwithstanding the foregoing, Landlord and Tenant agree Landlord shall make certain improvements to the Premises, as set forth on the attached Exhibit B (collectively, the "Build-Out Work"). Tenant shall maintain the Premises in satisfactory condition during the Term (subject to contribution from Tenant for damage to any of these structures caused by Tenant, its employees, agents, licensees or invitees). Landlord shall not be responsible for any damages caused by failure to maintain any of the foregoing items unless and until Landlord has received written notice of a problem and has had a reasonable time to repair the same. Tenant shall not make any modifications to the Premises without Landlord's express written consent. Any approved modifications shall become part of the Premises and shall become Landlord's property upon termination of the Lease. Landlord has the right to specify approved contractors who will do any work or maintenance within the Premises.
- **Default.** Landlord may declare Tenant in default if Tenant: (i) fails to pay any Rent or any other sums due under this Lease within ten (10) days of the due date; (ii) fails to perform any of its other obligations under this Lease and the failure shall continue for fifteen (15) days following written notice from Landlord; or (iii) if the Premises shall be deserted or vacated for a period of more than seven (7) days. Landlord only has to grant the foregoing applicable grace periods (i.e., ten (10) days for failure to pay Rent and fifteen (15) days for any other violation) twice in any consecutive two (2) month period before electing to immediately declare Tenant in default for future failures of performance. If Tenant fails to pay the Rent within the ten (10) day grace period, Landlord shall have the option to declare the Tenant in default or assess a late fee of ten percent (10%) of the past-due amount. If the past-due Rent (plus late fees) is not paid in full, Landlord shall have the option each succeeding day to either assess a Fifty and No/100 Dollars (\$50.00) per day late fee or declare Tenant in default. Exercise of the option to assess a late fee instead of declaring Tenant in default shall not waive Landlord's right to declare Tenant in default in the future. After Landlord declares Tenant in default, Landlord may immediately terminate this Lease and/or pursue any remedies available at law or equity, including without limitation, altering all locks and other security devices without terminating this Lease and leasing the Premises for the account of Tenant without releasing Tenant from Tenant's obligations under this Lease or accepting Tenant's surrender.
- 5. <u>Signage</u>. Tenant may display signage on the Premises. All signage displayed by Tenant must be approved by Landlord, in writing, prior to Tenant displaying such signage. Tenant must remove its signage upon termination of the Lease and return the area where the signage was located to its previous condition.
- 6. No Waste and Environmental Indemnity. Tenant agrees that it will not commit waste nor permit waste to be done to or upon the Premises. Tenant shall keep and maintain the Premises in compliance with, and shall not cause or permit the Premises to be in violation of, any federal, state or local laws, ordinances or regulations relating to occupational hazards, industrial hygiene or to the environmental conditions on, under, about or affecting the Premises. Tenant shall not use, generate, manufacture, store or dispose of on, under or about the Premises or transport to or from the Premises any

flammable explosives, radioactive materials, hazardous wastes, toxic substances or related materials, including without limitation any substances defined as or included in the definition of hazardous substances, hazardous wastes, hazardous materials or toxic substances under any applicable federal or state laws or regulations (collectively, the "Hazardous Materials"). If Tenant desires to have Hazardous Materials on the Premises, Tenant must make written request to Landlord detailing the specific Hazardous Materials and documenting to Landlord's satisfaction the Tenant's plan for managing the Hazardous Materials, keeping the Hazardous Materials from contaminating the Premises, complying with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Landlord shall have no obligation to permit the Hazardous Materials on the Premises. In the event Landlord approves the presence of the Hazardous Materials, Tenant shall be bound to comply with the plans it specified for the storage and disposal of the Hazardous Materials and, no matter what, shall keep the Hazardous Materials from contaminating the Premises and, no matter what, shall comply with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Landlord shall not be required to incur any expense in connect with such compliance. Tenant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Landlord from any loss, cost, liability or other expense caused as a result of Tenant having Hazardous Materials on the Premises. If Tenant does not remediate, to Landlord's satisfaction, any contamination caused by Hazardous Materials within thirty (30) days after notice, Landlord may undertake the remediation and Tenant shall immediately reimburse Landlord for the cost thereof.

- 7. <u>Insurance</u>. Tenant shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Landlord from and against any and all loss resulting from Tenant's occupation or use of the Premises. Landlord shall provide no insurance for any property of Tenant and shall not be liable for any business interruption related to any casualty or loss. Tenant shall at all times be responsible for maintaining adequate levels of insurance on its property. Additionally, Tenant shall maintain at all times a commercial general liability insurance policy with an annual aggregate and per occurrence liability limits of not less than \$1,000,000.00. The policy shall name Landlord as an additional insured and shall contain a provision that the insurance will not be terminated or modified without at least thirty (30) days prior written notice to Landlord. The policy shall also include a waiver of subrogation against Landlord. Landlord shall have the right at any time to request a certificate of insurance or such other evidence as Landlord may desire confirming the existence of the insurance as required by this Section. All insurance must be placed with a company having an A.M. Best's Financial Strength Rating of B++ or higher.
- 8. Condemnation/Casualty. If the whole or a portion of the Premises shall be taken by any public or quasi-public authority under any statute or by right of eminent domain, or by private purchase in lieu thereof, and the portion remaining after the taking cannot, in the sole judgment of Landlord, be used economically or profitably, then, on written notice from Landlord to Tenant or on written notice from Tenant to the Landlord, to be effective as of the effective date of the taking, this Lease shall terminate. If a portion of the Premises shall be condemned, and, in the determination of Landlord, the remaining portion can be operated economically and profitably, this Lease, as to such part, shall continue in full force and effect, and the rents payable hereunder shall be reduced in proportion to the portion taken, and, as to the portion taken, this Lease shall terminate. All condemnation awards or proceeds, whether for the whole or a portion of the Premises shall belong to and be the property of Landlord; provided, however, that Tenant shall have the right to recover from the condemning authority compensation for the taking of any personal property of Tenant, and any relocation costs incurred by Tenant. Notwithstanding anything herein, Landlord may terminate this Lease if Landlord deems such loss to be detrimental to Landlord.
- 9. <u>Casualty</u>. If the Premises are totally or partially destroyed by fire or other casualty, Landlord may terminate this Lease or elect to rebuild as follows. If the Premises are totally or partially destroyed by fire or other casualty so that they cannot be restored or made suitable for Tenant's business needs, as determined by Landlord, within one (1) month from the date of the casualty or the date of expiration of the Term, whichever occurs earlier (the "Rebuild Date"), either Landlord or Tenant may terminate this Lease by giving written notice to the other party within ten (10) days after the date of the casualty, failure

to do so within the specified time period shall mean that the Lease is in full effect. To the extent of the insurance proceeds allocable to the Premises, Landlord will restore the Premises as nearly as possible to the condition which existed immediately prior to such casualty. If Landlord, subject to unavoidable delays or force majeure, does not restore the Premises by the Rebuild Date, Tenant may terminate this Lease. Such restoration shall be commenced promptly and prosecuted with reasonable diligence. Notwithstanding anything herein, Landlord may terminate this Lease if Landlord deems such loss to be detrimental to Landlord.

- 10. <u>Taxes</u>. Landlord shall pay all ad valorem real property taxes for the Premises, but Tenant shall be solely responsible for all other taxes, including without limitation taxes for all property owned by Tenant.
- 11. <u>Utilities; Trash; Common Area</u>. Landlord will be responsible for all utilities furnished to the Premises and used by Tenant. Tenant shall reimburse Landlord for Tenant's proportionate share the expenses for such utilities, in proportion with all other tenants at the Development, as Additional Rent. Any such reimbursement payments shall be due within fifteen (15) days of such date Landlord delivers Tenant an invoice for such utility payments. Landlord shall provide a shared dumpster for the Development, subject to monthly reimbursement by Tenant for Tenant's proportionate share of the expenses for such dumpster, as Additional Rent. Tenant shall remove and properly dispose of all Tenant's trash on the Premises in the designated dumpster.

Landlord shall be responsible for maintaining the common areas of the Development, including without limitation lighting, parking areas, mowing and landscaping, trash disposal, at Landlord's expense. However, Tenant shall reimburse Landlord for Tenant's proportionate share the expenses for such common area maintenance and management in proportion with all other tenants at the Development, as Additional Rent. Any such reimbursement payments shall be due within fifteen (15) days of such date Landlord delivers Tenant an invoice for such common area maintenance expenses.

- 12. <u>Compliance with Applicable Law</u>. Tenant shall comply at all times during the Term with all applicable laws, ordinances and regulations. Tenant shall comply with all rules and regulations provided in the Memorandum attached as <u>Exhibit C</u> hereto (the "Memorandum") and any memorandum or other publication, applicable to Tenant, issued as a supplement, amendment, as a replacement for or in addition to the Memorandum.
- 13. **Right of Entry**. Landlord reserves the right during the Term to enter the Premises during normal business hours of Tenant, after reasonable prior notice to Tenant, for purposes of inspecting the Premises. During the last two (2) months of the Term or any extensions of the Term, Landlord may enter the Premises as needed from time to time as is customary with the re-leasing of the Premises.
- 14. <u>Bankruptcy</u>. If Tenant shall become insolvent or if bankruptcy proceedings shall be instituted by or against Tenant during the terms of this Lease, Landlord is hereby irrevocably authorized, at its option, to cancel this Lease for default. Landlord may elect to accept rent from such receiver, trustee, or other judicial officer during the term of their fiduciary capacity without affecting Landlord's rights as contained in this Lease, but no receiver, trustee, or other judicial officer are granted any right, title, or interest in or to the Premises by virtue of the terms of this Lease.
- 15. <u>Notices</u>. Any notice or demand required or permitted to be delivered hereunder may be delivered in person or shall be deemed to be delivered when deposited in the United States mail, postage prepaid, registered or certified mail, return receipt requested. Notice shall also be deemed to have been delivered when deposited, prepaid, with any overnight express mail service, addressed as provided below:

- 16. No Oral Agreements. This written agreement may not be contradicted by evidence of prior, contemporaneous or subsequent oral agreement of the parties. There are no unwritten oral agreements between the parties. Any provision of this Lease may be changed, waived or terminated only by written instrument specifically referring to this Lease signed by the party against whom the change, waiver or termination is sought to be enforced. Each of the parties hereto hereby acknowledges no other party, or agent or attorney of any other party, has made any promise, representation or warranty whatsoever, express or implied, not contained herein concerning the subject matter hereof, to induce the other party to execute this Lease or any of the other documents referred to herein and each party hereto acknowledges it has not executed this Lease or such other documents in reliance upon any such promise, representation or warranty not contained herein.
- 17. Construction. This Lease and all provisions contained herein have been jointly drafted (or reviewed and negotiated) and agreed to, and shall be deemed to have been prepared jointly by the parties hereto, each being sophisticated in transactions such as the one contemplated by this Lease and each having the benefit and advice of legal counsel (or the opportunity to seek such counsel), and shall not be construed in favor of or against any party to this Lease. This Lease may be executed in counterparts. This Lease shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arkansas, and Arkansas shall be the exclusive forum for any disputes arising in connection with this Lease. If any part of this Lease or any other agreement entered into pursuant hereto is contrary to, prohibited by or deemed invalid under applicable law or regulation, such provision shall be deemed inapplicable and deemed omitted to the extent so contrary, prohibited or invalid but the remainder hereof shall not be invalidated thereby and shall be given full force and effect so far as possible. Time is of the essence with respect to all obligations of Tenant set forth in this Lease.
- 18. Estoppel Certificate. Tenant agrees that it will from time to time, upon request by Landlord, execute and deliver to Landlord within ten (10) business days after demand therefor an estoppel certificate in Landlord's form certifying that this Lease is unmodified and in full force and effect (or if there have been modifications, that the same is in full force and effect as so modified).
- 19. <u>Rules and Regulations</u>. Landlord reserves the right to make, establish and amend, from time to time, in Landlord's sole discretion, subject to the provisions herein, reasonable rules and regulations which shall be applicable to the Premises and the Tenant. Tenant shall comply with such rules and regulations as may be set forth from time to time.
- 20. Representations and Warranties of Tenant. Tenant hereby represents and warrants to Landlord that: (i) Tenant as full power and authority to execute and deliver this Lease, and to perform its obligations hereunder; (ii) this Lease has been duly executed and delivered by Tenant and constitutes the

legal, valid and binding obligation of Tenant, enforceable in accordance with its terms, except to the extent that such enforceability may be limited by bankruptcy, insolvency, reorganization, moratorium or other similar laws affecting the enforcement of creditor's rights or by general principles of equity; and (iii) neither the execution nor delivery of this Lease by Tenant, nor the performance by Tenant of its obligations hereunder will (a) violate or conflict with the provisions of, or constitute an event of default under any note, loan, mortgage, indenture, deed of trust, license, lease or other agreement to which Tenant is a party, or to which it or any of its properties may be bound; or (b) violate any judgment, ruling, order, writ, injunction, decree, statute, rule or regulation applicable to Tenant, or any of its properties or assets.

- 21. <u>Waiver</u>. The failure of any party to enforce any of the provisions of this Lease, or any rights with respect hereto, or the failure to exercise any right provided for herein, will in no way be considered a waiver of such provisions, rights or elections, or in any way affect the validity of this Lease. The failure of any party to enforce any such provisions, rights or remedies will not prejudice such party from later enforcing or exercising the same or any other provisions, rights or remedies which it may have under this Lease. No custom or practice which may evolve between the parties in the administration of the terms of this Lease shall waive or diminish the right of either party to insist upon the performance by the parties in strict accordance with the terms hereof.
- 22. <u>Attorney's Fees</u>. The prevailing party in any litigation instituted to enforce the terms of this Lease shall recover from the other party, in addition to any other relief or damages awarded, such prevailing party's attorney's fees, and costs and expenses incurred in prosecuting any such litigation.
- 23. **No Broker**. Tenant has not, directly or indirectly, engaged a broker or finder in connection with this transaction and no person has or will have, as a result of this Lease, any right, interest or claim against or upon Landlord for any commission, fee or other compensation payable as a result of any act or omission of Tenant.
- 24. **Real Estate Agent**. This Lease was negotiated by Halsey Thrasher Harpole LLC ("Broker"), acting as agent for Landlord, who does not represent Tenant. Landlord agrees to pay Broker a commission pursuant to separate agreement. Landlord and Tenant acknowledge that some members of Landlord, including without limitation Jerry Halsey, Jr., Gary Harpole, and Roddy Thrasher, are licensed real estate brokers in the State of Arkansas.
- 25. <u>Guaranty</u>. The full performance and payment of Tenant's obligations under this Lease are expressly guaranteed by **Michael Patterson and Michleia Patterson** an individual ("Guarantor"), who Tenant acknowledges and agrees is receiving a direct benefit as a result of this Lease with Landlord, pursuant to the form of guaranty attached hereto as <u>Exhibit D</u> (the "Guaranty").

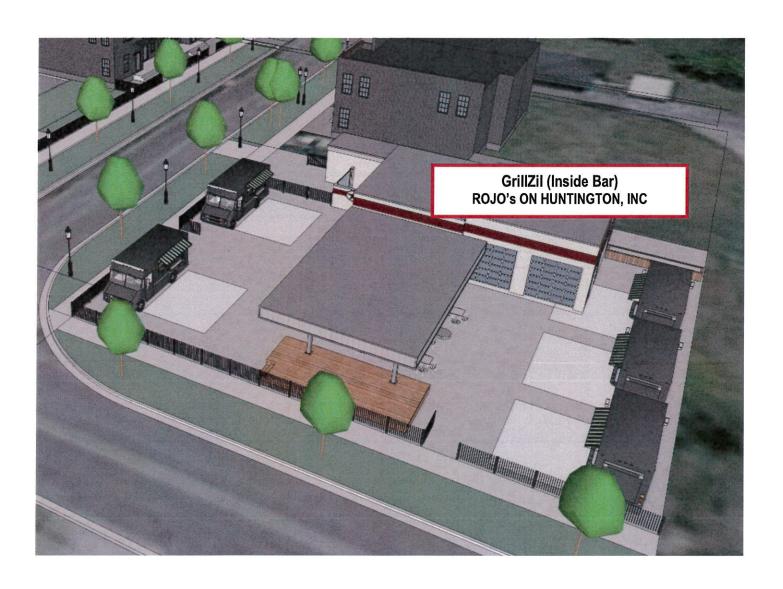

[MEMORANDUM OF VENDOR RULES]

Introduction: The Huntington Station Food Truck Court goal is to bring a completely different experience to Jonesboro with space for the community to eat, drink, and interact in a fun and casual environment. We will provide entrepreneurial opportunities to vendors, diverse food offerings to patrons, and additional street level amenities to our collective customers. The Food Truck Court will essentially create a small business ecosystem. The operators can use us to grow and sustain their own small business and we can help to incubate and grow food businesses, with a focus on first-time food truck operators, businesses owned by Jonesboro residents, and food trucks that are not vending in other outdoor Jonesboro venues on a regular basis. As the food business industry continues to grow and change, food truck trailers have become an attractive, low-cost option for starting a food business. Allowing food trailers or food trucks to vend at Huntington Station Food Court aligns with our goals to lower the barrier for food entrepreneurs to test menu options and marketing for their business.

The court is about food, but it is also about being active and socializing. It's not just about sitting at a table. We want to create a space in town that encourages people to mingle. People tend to chat with others as they wait in line at food trucks. They speak to the operators, to other diners, encourage each other to try new things. The food court is much more than just a place where up to five food trucks can park and sell food - it is a "local foodie celebration".

To operate respectfully, cohesively, efficiently, and in the spirit of shared resources and customers, the Lessees of Huntington Station Food Court adopt and agree to the following guidelines and incorporate the same into each of their respective Leases:

- 1. Trucks and/or trailers do not need to be licensed or permitted in Arkansas at the time of Lease commencement, however trucks and/or trailers will need to be fully licensed and permitted to do business in the City of Jonesboro prior to the start of the vending activity. Failure to produce copies of the necessary permits, licenses, and certificates will result in a breach in the terms of lease and this addendum of the lease.
- 2. The food court will initially contain 7 (seven) spaces for food trucks/trailers and 1 (one) space for a bar.
 - a. The food court will attempt to diversify the types of food operators to avoid unnecessary competition and food offering redundancy among the Lessees.
 - b. The bar Lessee shall not sell, donate, trade, barter, vend, gift, or otherwise transact hot or cold food items of any type at any time other than garnishes that are included in drinks/cocktails.
 - c. In recognition of the bar Lessee's financial disadvantage to generate revenue from food sales, the bar Lessee shall have the sole and exclusive right to sell all beverages on the premises and;

- d. The truck and/or trailer Lessees shall not sell, donate, trade, barter, vend, gift, or otherwise transact hot or cold beverages/drinks of any type at any time other than under the following conditions:
 - i. In the interest of customer satisfaction, the bar may choose to license non-alcohol drink/beverage sales to the truck/trailer Lessees for a per unit fee established by the bar Lessee.
 - ii. If the bar Lessee chooses to license beverage/drink sales to food truck/trailer Lessees, the bar Lessee must allow all food truck/trailer Lessees to equally participate and obtain licenses under identical terms and conditions. The bar may not revoke licenses for beverage/drink sales except in the event a truck/trailer Lessee is in breach of the terms and conditions of the license (i.e. non-payment for license(s), unauthorized pricing, etc).
 - iii. If the bar Lessee chooses to license beverage/drink sales to food truck/trailer Lessees, the bar shall guarantee the food truck/trailer Lessees a profit margin on each drink sale of **no less than 50% (fifty percent)**. All food truck/trailer Lessees and the bar lessee will sell non-alcohol beverages for the same retail price to customers which will be established by the bar Lessee following the above 50% minimum profit rule.
 - The formula to calculate markup percentage is:
 Markup Percentage = ((Sales Price License Cost)/
 License Cost) * 100
 . For example, if a license costs \$0.85 and the retail sales price for a beverage is \$1.90,
 \$1.90 \$0.85 = \$1.05; \$1.05/\$0.85 = \$1.24; 1.24 * 100 = 124% Markup
 - 2. Food truck/trailer Lessees may not insert a beverage/drink into a combo type menu offering, discount drinks, gift drinks, or otherwise attempt to disguise or circumvent the retail price established for the non-alcohol beverage/drink.
 - iv. Whether the bar Lessee chooses to license beverage/drink sales to food truck/trailer Lessees or not, the bar shall be responsible for the overhead costs associated with the appropriate beverage/drink delivery or dispensing system and availability to the customer including, but not limited to, purchasing syrup, cups, lids, straws, ice, CO2, staffing the fountain machine, purchasing equipment, maintaining equipment, occupancy costs, customer refill costs, and insurance.

Hours of operation...i.e. must be ready to serve at 11:00am Monday- Sunday. You will be considered late if you are on property but not ready to serve. What are the remedies if a Lessee does not comply with the above or: Is late or no shows, leaves, or is unable to manage the volume to keep reasonable wait times.

Must provide your food service permits, business license, and proof of insurance? Signage permissions (how far from the trailer/truck can it be placed?)

Must follow all local, state, and federal laws in relation to their business operations?

Agree to meet quarterly with other Lessees to discuss improvements, concerns, or other topics needed?

Address the stage and how the entertainment is chosen or paid for? Who controls music in the absence of live entertainment?

Guarantor hereby expressly waives notice of all defaults and hereby waives all suretyship defenses. Guarantor agrees that the waiver of any rights by Landlord against Tenant arising out of defaults by Tenant, shall not in any way modify or release the obligations of Guarantor.

The undersigned agrees that, in the event of a default by Tenant under the Lease, Landlord may proceed against the undersigned before, after or simultaneously with or in lieu of proceeding against Tenant.

If Landlord, at any time, is compelled to take action, by legal proceedings or otherwise, to enforce or compel compliance with the terms of this Guaranty, the undersigned shall, in addition to any other rights or remedies to which Landlord may be entitled hereunder or as a matter of law or in equity, pay to Landlord all costs, including reasonable attorneys' fees, incurred or expended by Landlord in connection therewith.

In the event the Lease is disaffirmed by a trustee in a bankruptcy proceeding for Tenant, the undersigned agrees that it shall, at the election of Landlord, either assume the Lease and perform all of the covenants, terms and conditions of Tenant thereunder or enter into a new Lease which said new Lease shall be in form and substance identical to the Lease.

This Guaranty, the Lease and all amendments and modifications thereto, except as set forth in the Lease or in any such amendment or modification, shall be binding upon Guarantor. If the Lease is assigned, Guarantor waives any requirement that Guarantor reaffirm this Guaranty in order for Guarantor's obligations under this Guaranty to continue to be binding on Guarantor following any such assignment of the Lease, but Guarantor shall not be liable for any increase in Tenant's obligations under the Lease, which increase shall occur following: any assignment of the Lease by the Tenant named in the Lease; or any assignment of the ownership interests in the Tenant named in the Lease to any entity which is not affiliated with Tenant.

This Guaranty shall inure to the benefit of the Landlord and its heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns; and shall be binding upon the Guarantor and its heirs, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

For purposes of this Guaranty, the word "Tenant" shall also include the successors, heirs, executors, personal representatives, trustees, guardians, conservators and permitted assigns of Tenant.

This Guaranty shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of Arkansas.

IN THE INTEREST OF OBTAINING A SPEEDIER AND LESS COSTLY HEARING OF ANY DISPUTE, LANDLORD AND GUARANTOR EACH HEREBY EXPRESSLY WAIVES TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY ACTION, PROCEEDING, COUNTERCLAIM OR CROSSCLAIM BROUGHT BY

EITHER PARTY AGAINST THE OTHER AND ANY RIGHTS TO A TRIAL BY JURY UNDER ANY STATUTE, RULE OF LAW OR PUBLIC POLICY IN CONNECTION WITH ANY MATTER WHATSOEVER ARISING OUT OF OR IN ANY WAY RELATING TO THIS GUARANTY OR THE LEASE. Although such jury waiver is intended to be self operative and irrevocable, Landlord and Guarantor further agree, if requested to confirm such waivers in writing at the time of commencement of any such action, proceeding, counterclaim, or crossclaim.

 - Il If approval by members was required:
 - (a) the designation, number of memberships outstanding, number of votes entitled to be cast by each class entitled to vote separately on the amendment, and the number of votes of each class indisputably voting on the amendment; and
 - (b) either the total number of votes cast for and against the amendment by each class entitled to vote separately on the amendment or the total number of undisputed votes cast for the amendment by each class and a statement that the number cast for the amendment by each class was sufficient for approval by that class.
 - III if the approval of the amendment by some person or persons other than the members, the board or incorporators is required pursuant to § 4-33-1030, a statement that the approval was obtained.
