Code Enforcement Officer Michael Tyner stated that this property falls within the eastern footprint of the proposed overpass at Nettleton and Highland. Mr. Kissee is going to be occupied for a while. I spoke to his Property Manager. He advised me that they are currently working with the State Highway Department so that the Highway Department can acquire the property. In turn, they are going to demolish the house there when they begin construction on the overpass. I believe that it may be financially advisable for us to table this as the property has approximately \$62,000 worth of IRS liens on it as it is now. We currently have \$2,700 worth of demolition liens for the lot next to it where we removed the house in 2015. I don't believe that it would be financially prudent to invest anymore money into a property that the State is going to take for a right-of-way.

Councilmember Chris Gibson asked if we needed to do this in committee or do we do it at Council? Councilmember Chris Moore said that we could kill this right here if the desire of this committee is to do so.
