WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Jonesboro has adopted by ordinance the Metropolitan Area Transportation Authority Street and Highway Planning Study; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro will reach the population level warranting the designation as a Metropolitan Statistical Area, possibly as early as the next two years, and must have an official traffic plan in order to participate in a number of transportation programs funded by the United States Government; and

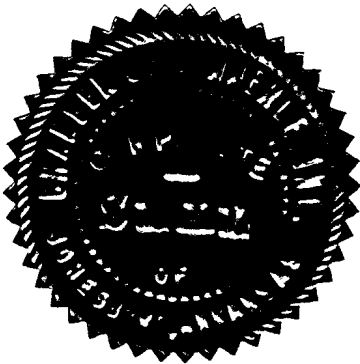
WHEREAS, more than 10 percent of the people who voted in the last general election have affixed their signatures to a petition calling for a referendum to approve or disapprove the Metropolitan Area Transportation Authority Street and Highway Planning Study as adopted by the City Council;

BE IT NOW THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Greater Jonesboro Chamber of Commerce encourage the continued support by the City Council and all registered voters, for the adopted plan.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council be encouraged to set the referendum date on November 3rd, 1992, in conjunction with the General Election in order that the greatest number of registered voters be given the opportunity to decide the issue.
