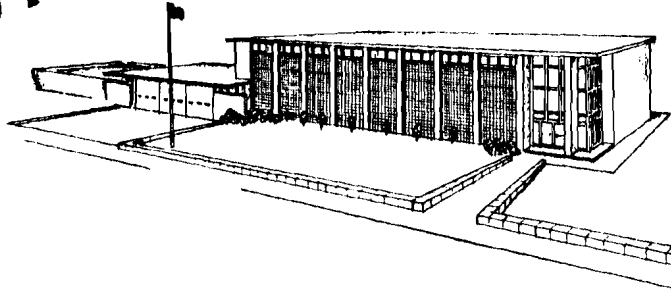

Mayor Stallings:

In an official meeting the City Planning Commission studied the usage of Brown's Lane and its future as one of the necessary permanent streets in the area of the Arkansas Services Center.

Research of the 1980 Land Use and Transportation Plan reveals that Brown's Lane is the south segment of a proposed East Arterial that would connect Highway 63 by-pass on the south and Johnson Avenue on the north. With these facts in mind and the knowledge that there is increased interest in all of the area between the by-pass and Highland Drive the City Planning Commission voted to recommend to you and the City Council that a right-of-way of 100 feet be established for Brown's Lane from Highway 63 by-pass to Highland Drive.

We respectfully request that this be considered at your earliest convenience.
