**RESOLUTION OF AIRPORT COMMISSION  
CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS**

**WHEREAS, the Airport Commission of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, has been appointed, pursuant to statute, and charged with the duty of managing the Municipal Airport, and, it appearing that certain properties adjacent thereto are not required for Airport purposes but the consideration for the sale of same is needed for the preservation of the Airport properties, particularly the runways, which, if not improved, will very soon deteriorate to the point where Jonesboro cannot expect regular air service nor obtain the benefits of a municipal airport; and**

**WHEREAS, it is found that the price of \$1,000.00 per acre is a proper consideration for same, and the sale of said tract has been approved by the Civil Aeronautics Administration:**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

**Section 1. That the Chairman and Secretary of the Airport Commission of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, sell, and they are directed to execute and deliver Warranty Deed to said property, in conjunction with the Mayor and the City Clerk of the City of Jonesboro, and to sign such other Options or Contracts as they deem proper to carry out the intention of this Resolution. Such sale to be made to grantees as determined by said officers and officials, and the land described being:**

**Begin at Quarter Corner of Sections 21 and 22, Township 14 North, Range 4 East, thence South on Quarter Section Line 130.5 feet to St. Louis-San Francisco Railway Company right-of-way line; thence North 44 degrees 08 minutes West along said right-of-way line 917.2 feet; thence North 46 degrees 49 minutes East 659.1 feet; thence North 42 degrees 27 minutes West 1782 feet to the southerly right-of-way line of the St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company to the point of beginning proper; thence South 42 degrees 27 minutes East 1782 feet; thence South 46 degrees 49 minutes East 659.1 feet to the easterly right-of-way line of the St. Louis-San Francisco Railway Company, thence North 44 degrees 08 minutes West**

1302.1 feet along said right-of-way line; thence North 0 degrees 03 minutes East 769.5 feet to the southerly right-of-way line of St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company, thence South 80 degrees 35 minutes East approximately 234.9 feet to the point of beginning proper, containing 16.5 acres, more or less.

Reserving an easement for load track that may be constructed by St. Louis Southwestern Railway Company at Railway's cost, not exceeding 20 feet in width along the northeasterly side of the tract.

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**CERTIFICATE**

The undersigned, Chairman and Secretary of the Jonesboro Airport Commission, state that the above Resolution was passed by unanimous vote of the Commission on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October, 1959, at a regular meeting, at which a quorum was present and unanimously voted for the adoption of same.
