Craighead Forest Park
Rules for Campground Area

1. Quiet time is 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM.
2. Checkout time is 1:00 PM.
3. Pets must be on a leash at all times.
 - a. Owner must continually clean up after pets.
 - b. Pets disturbing other campers must be brought under control by owners immediately or removed from the park.
4. Aleoholic beverages are prohibited.
5. Campsites must be kept clean and unclittered at all times.
6. Riotous, boisterous, threatening, or indecent conduct, or the use of abusive, threatening, profane, or indecent language shall not be indulged in.
7. Campers are responsible for their guest.
8. No outside appliances. (refrigerator, freezer, washers, etc.)
9. Gray water may be run on ground. Sewage Line dumping must be at the Dump Station. (Eviotion, notifiocation of Health Dept, and clean-up costs will apply for violators)
10. Maximum stay is 14 days within a 30 day period. Seven day extensions beyond this 14-day limit may be granted by the Park Superintendent when the eampgrounds are not at capaeity. Additional extensions must be approved by the Parks Director. Camping extensions will not qualify for any discounts beyond the initial 14 days. Extended stay campers in prime loeations may be required to move to a less desirable site.
11. Repeated violations of these rules after two warnings from park personnel may result in camper losing camping privileges bascd upon the severity of the violation.
