(b) If the political subdivision is unable to negotiate a satisfactory 17 - 18 contract with the firm selected, negotiations with that firm shall be 19 terminated. The political subdivision shall then undertake negotiations with 20 another of the qualified firms selected. If there is a failing of accord with 21 the second firm, negotiations with such firm shall be terminated. The (c) If the political subdivision is unable to negotiate a contract with 24 any of the selected firms, the agency whall reevaluate the necessary legal, architectural, engineering or land surveying services, including the scope and 27 reasonable fee requirements, again compile a list of qualified firms and proceed in accordance with the provisions of this act. 28 SECTION 6. All provisions of this act of a general and permanent nature are amendatory to the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated and the Arkansas Code Ŗ Revision Commission shall incorporate the same in the Code.
