Attached is a request for the relinquishment of easement and abandoning of portions of Hope and Lutterloh Streets in Jonesboro. The proposed plan is to abandon the existing utility easement to remove existing utilities for the construction of the Clopton Medical Clinic. I have no objections to the abandonment of the existing easement provided the owner or developer agree to be responsible for any and all costs incurred with removing or abandoning the existing telephone plant on the property. This would require deactivating and removing a small section of a 25 pair cable at the south end of the property and removing three CPL-6 pedestals located along the portion of Lutterloh Street to be abandoned. Another requirement would be to maintain the existing Right of way and/or utility easements, assumed or actual, adjacent to the property and Monroe, Carson, Creath and Bridge Streets to maintain existing telephone plant. If removal or relocation of this plant is necessary, the owner or developer must be responsible for those costs.
