

CROSS TRAINING 2008-09

- All Plumbing/HVAC State Level Certified
- Inspectors are cross trained in all fields,
 - All of the Inspectors work together to have a quicker response time when an inspection is needed.
 - All Code Enforcement Officer, will be trained for Plumbing and HVAC State Level Inspections

COST-EFFECTIVE CHANGES

- Equipment
 - Inspectors are better equipped in the field.
 - This includes having a print capability by laser to mobile printers.
- New equipment is allowing the Inspections
 Department to save all inspections to a file that is backed up by Information Systems.
 - This reduces the paper cost for the Inspections Department by approximately 75%.
 - Code Enforcement will receive updated equipment to insure proper field inspections and accuracy of inspections.

ICC LEVEL TRAINING

- All Inspectors and the Permit Technician are enrolled in ICC Level courses for their specialty field
 - This makes the Inspector better equipped to perform a higher level of inspection due to detailed study.
 - All ISO requirements placed upon the inspection department have been meet or will be meet by September 2009.
 - All Code Enforcement Officers will receive ICC level training for a specialty field with-in the inspection department

PLAN REVIEW AND PERMITS

- The Inspections Department strives to maintain a 2 day turn around on plan reviews.
 - The Department reviews the plans after all of the other departments have finished their reviews.
- As opposed to residential plans, commercial plans take a little longer to adequately review due to the complexity of the plans

COOPERATION WITH OTHER DEPARTMENTS

The Inspections/Code Enforcement
 Department strives to work as closely as possible with all departments to ensure a proper code analysis has been completed and all requirements are meet before construction occurs.
