

## CONTRACT FOR SERVICES:

This document evidences an agreement between the City of Jonesboro,, Arkansas, (First Party) and -Joneboro Chapter #26, Disabled American Veterans, (Second Party).

It is the purpose of this agreement to set forth the operations and services to be provided to the eligible veterans citizens of Jonesboro area through the work of the Second Party, which is to be financed in whole or in part by allocations of annual funding from First Party.

Second Party's purposes as stated in its Constution and by-laws are to;- Uphold and maintain the Constution and the laws of the United States, to realize thre true American ideals and aims for which those eligible to membership fought; to advance the interests and work for the betterment of all wounded, gassed, injured and disabled veterans, to cooperate with the United States Department of Veterans Affairs and all the public and private agencies devoted to the cause of improving and advancing the condition, health;and interest of all wounded, gased, injured and disabled veterans; to stimulate a feeling of mutual devotion, helpfulness and comradeship among all wounded, gased , injured and disabled veterans, to serve our comrades, our communities and our country; and to encourage in all people that spirit of understanding which will guard against future wars.

First Party will Provide the sum of \$ 5,000.<sup>00</sup> to Second Party for the year 2007

Second Party's operations are supervised by the Department of Veterans Affairs, Disabled American Veterans Service Commission, Department of Arkansas and the National Organization Disabled American Veterans.

The Second Party Shall perform the following duties:

The Disabled American Veterans Transportation Program under the sponsorship of the Jonesboro Chapter #26 Disabled American Veterans agrees to transport needy and eligable veterans to and from Department of Veterans Affairs Medical facilities in Memphis Tennessee and Little Rock and North Little Rock Arkansas, on a regular schedule provided by the station it serves to keep their appointments for treatment. This service is provided to the veterans free of charge.

It is understood and agreed that this agreement is effective from January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2007. Second Party shall prepare and submit to First party quarterly reports on its activity and finances. Second party shall also prepare and submit to First Party, on or before July of each year, anrequest for funding with budget for inclusion in First Party's general budget for the following year

It is understood and agreed that this agreement may be cancelled by either party no later than October 10<sup>th</sup> of any year to be effective at the end of the current year.
