SUBJ:BUDGET 1991

The 1991 Budget is ready for your consideration. For your convenience, the major differences between the 1990 Budget and the 1991 Budget are outlined below.

- (1) An Accountant position is added to the Administration Budget. This position is necessary due to the increased requirements of the department. An amount of \$3,600 is included in the Admin. expense line item to be used as an unrestricted automobile allowance for the Finance Director.
- (2) Three (3) additional Patrolmen are included in the Police Budget. Also included, is \$30,000 for setting up an auxiliary patrol.
- (3) One (1) full time Secretary at January 1, and seven(7) additional Fire fighters at August 1, are included in the Fire Budget.
- (4) \$65,000 is distributed throughout all applicable budgets, to allow for the City's costs should all eligible non uniform employees buy into the civilian pension plan.
- (5) <u>Salary adjustments</u> are recommended and limited to as follows:

All other are to receive a 4.5 percent pay increase.

Items not included in this budget and subject to possible consideration during 1991 are:

- (1) The mosquito control program.
- (2) A Personnel Director.
- (3) Fire Stations and equipment in the annexed areas.
- (4) Safeway building renovations.
- (5) Any other major capital projects that may occur during the year.

Please contact the Mayor, The Finance Committee members or the Director of Finance if you have any questions pertaining to the Budget. It is anticipated that final approval can be voted on by December 17, 1990.




