



Jonesboro Miracle League Field and Playground



A Miracle Field is a field with a rubberized surface that will accommodate wheel chairs and walkers for physically challanged adults and children. This field will allow these individuals to play baseball, wheel chair basketball and wheel chair soccer, Challenger Kickball and Flag Football.

It will be located at Southside Softball Complex in Jonesboro. The Miracle League complex will include both a ballfield and a playground. The playground will have 28 different pieces of equipment and will all be handicap accessible.

Approximately 10% of a city's population has special needs. This complex will be used for special olympics, veterans that have physical challenges from the war and the well community also. This complex will serve not only Jonesboro, but all of Northeast Arkansas, Southeast MO., Western Tennessee and Northwest Mississippi.

The projected opening date is Fall of 2013.



There is something about playing the game that lights up a youngster's eyes. But for children facing serious physical and mental disabilities that opportunity can often be difficult to achieve. Baseball diamonds weren't exactly designed with wheelchairs and crutches in mind.

The Miracle League removes the barriers that keep children with mental and physical disabilities off the baseball field and lets them experience the joy of America's favorite pastime. Since the main barriers for these children arise from the natural grass fields used in conventional youth leagues, Miracle League teams play on a custom-designed, rubberized turf field that accommodates wheelchairs and other assertive devices while helping to prevent injuries.

But it's more than playing a game. The Miracle League is about making new friends, building self-esteem and being treated just like other kids. To help the athletes, the Miracle League uses a "buddy" system – pairing each player with an able-bodied peer. The result is a bond that cannot be described.
