AGREEMENT TO CLOSE AND ABANDON ALLEY

WHEREAS, it has been found and determined by the City
Council of Jonesboro, Arkansas, a City of the first class, that the
South 90 feet of the alley running North and South across Block "F"
of the Original Survey of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, is not
needed for highway purposes and that the welfare of the City of
Jonesboro will be enhanced and promoted by the closing and abandoning
of said portion of such alley, according to a Resolution of the City
Council of the City of Jonesboro, and:

WHEREAS, all adjacent property owners have agreed to the closing and abandoning of such portion of the alley, as well as the several utility companies which have utility lines or facilities in such portion of such alley are agreeable to the closing of such alley subject to the retention of their easement rights:

mentioned Resolution of the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, that

the South 90 feet of the alley which runs North and South across Block "F"

is hereby forever closed and abandoned, pursuant to the provisions of

Section 19-3817 of the Arkansas Statutes Annotated, subject only to the

retention of utility easements by the Southwestern Bell Telephone

Company and the City Water and Light Plant of Jonesboro, Arkansas,

and that as a result of such portion of such alley being closed and

abandoned legal title to such portion of such alley so closed has

vested in the owners of the property adjacent thereto in accordance

with the provisions of Section 19-3817 of the Arkansas Statutes Annotated.
