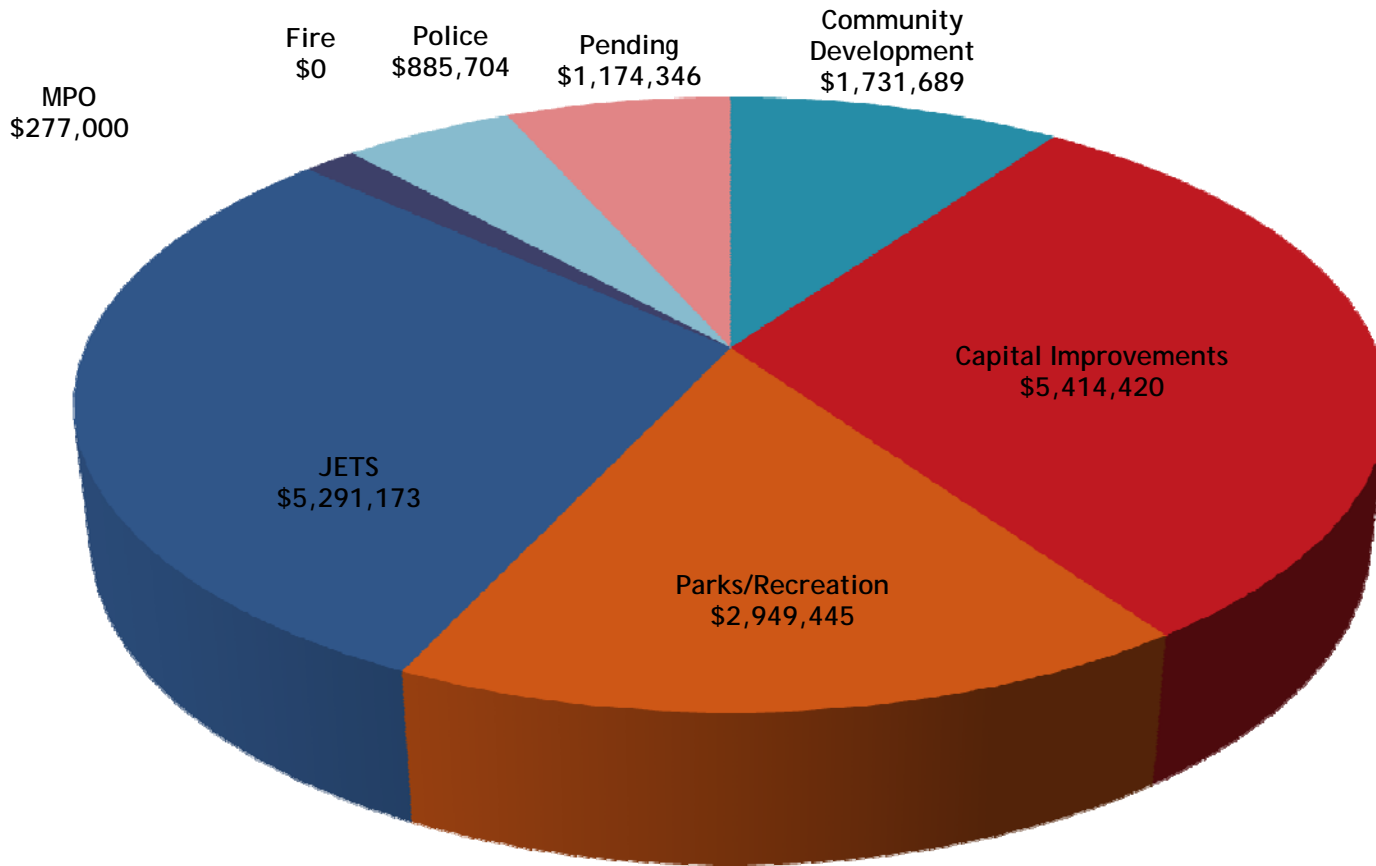
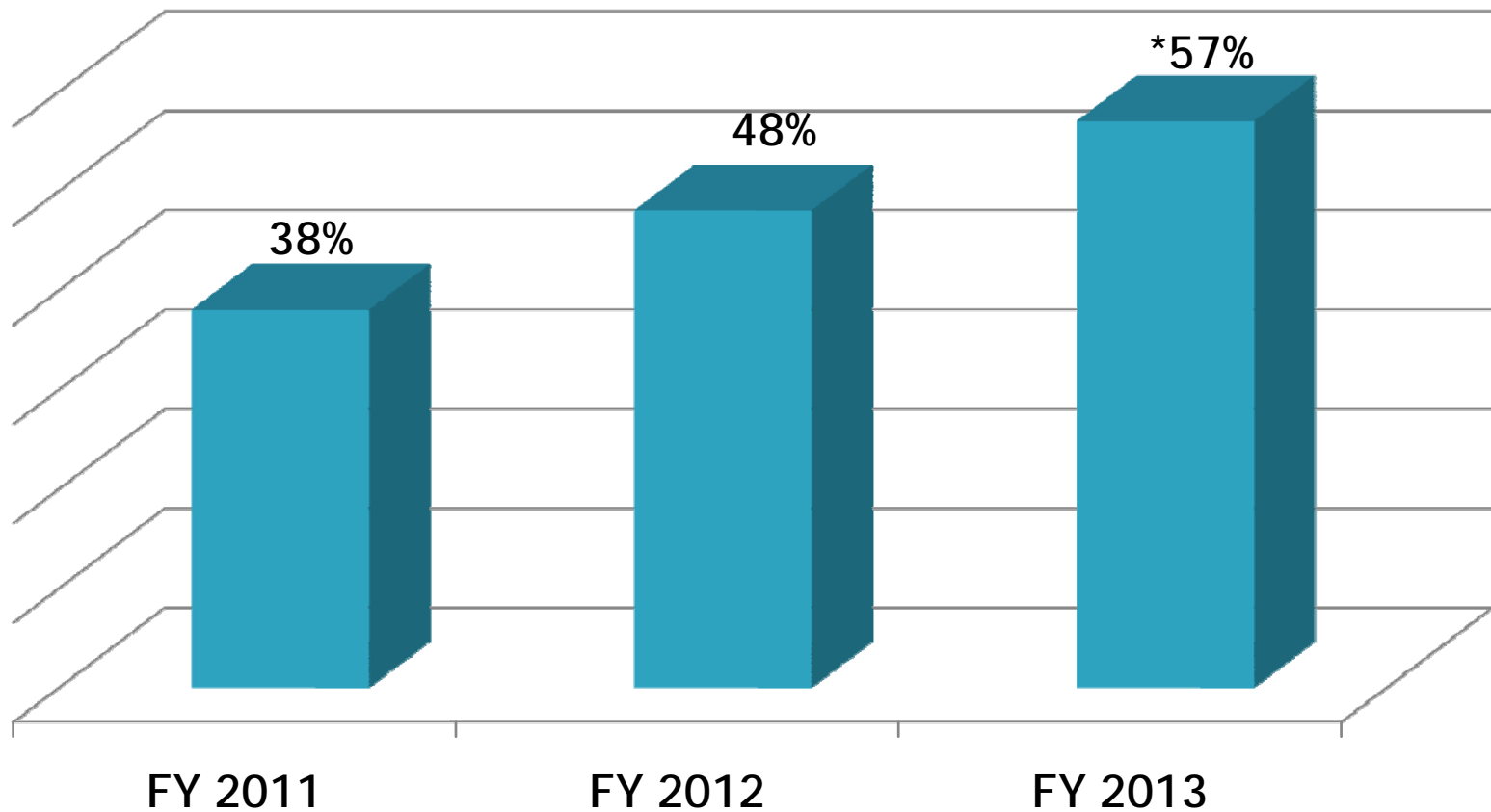

Three Year Comparison: Awards

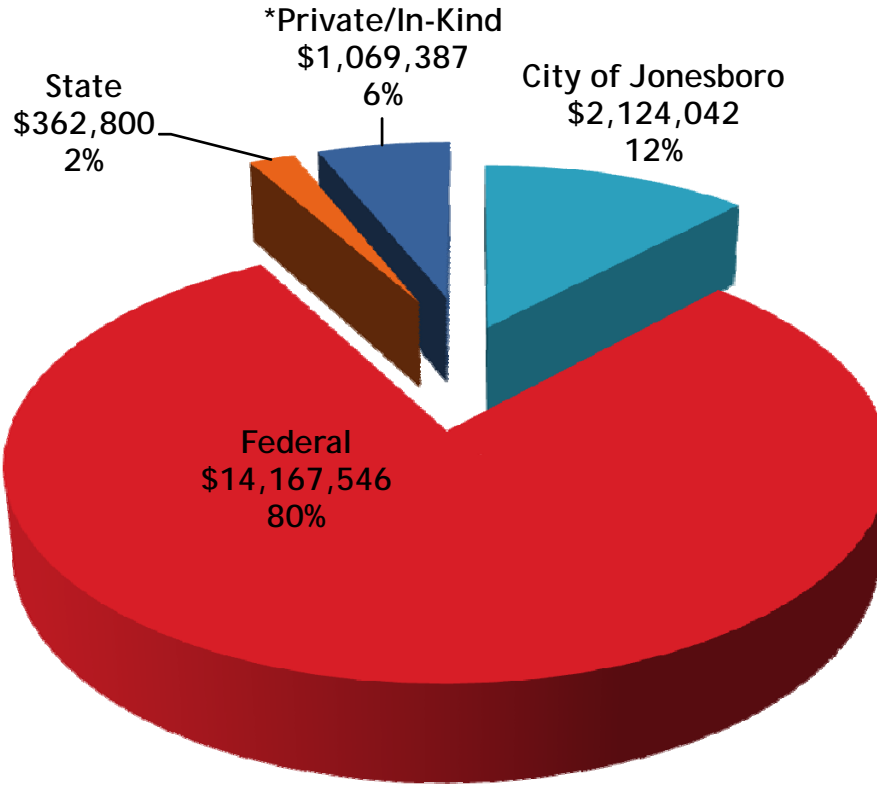


**Still two pending grants for FY 2013*

- Total Funds Awarded = \$10,978,997
 - 57% based on amount written
 - 60% based on number of (52/87)
- Total Grant Awards = 52
- Average per month = \$288,921 / 1.4

**Total private funds raised since 2011 = \$1,122,901*

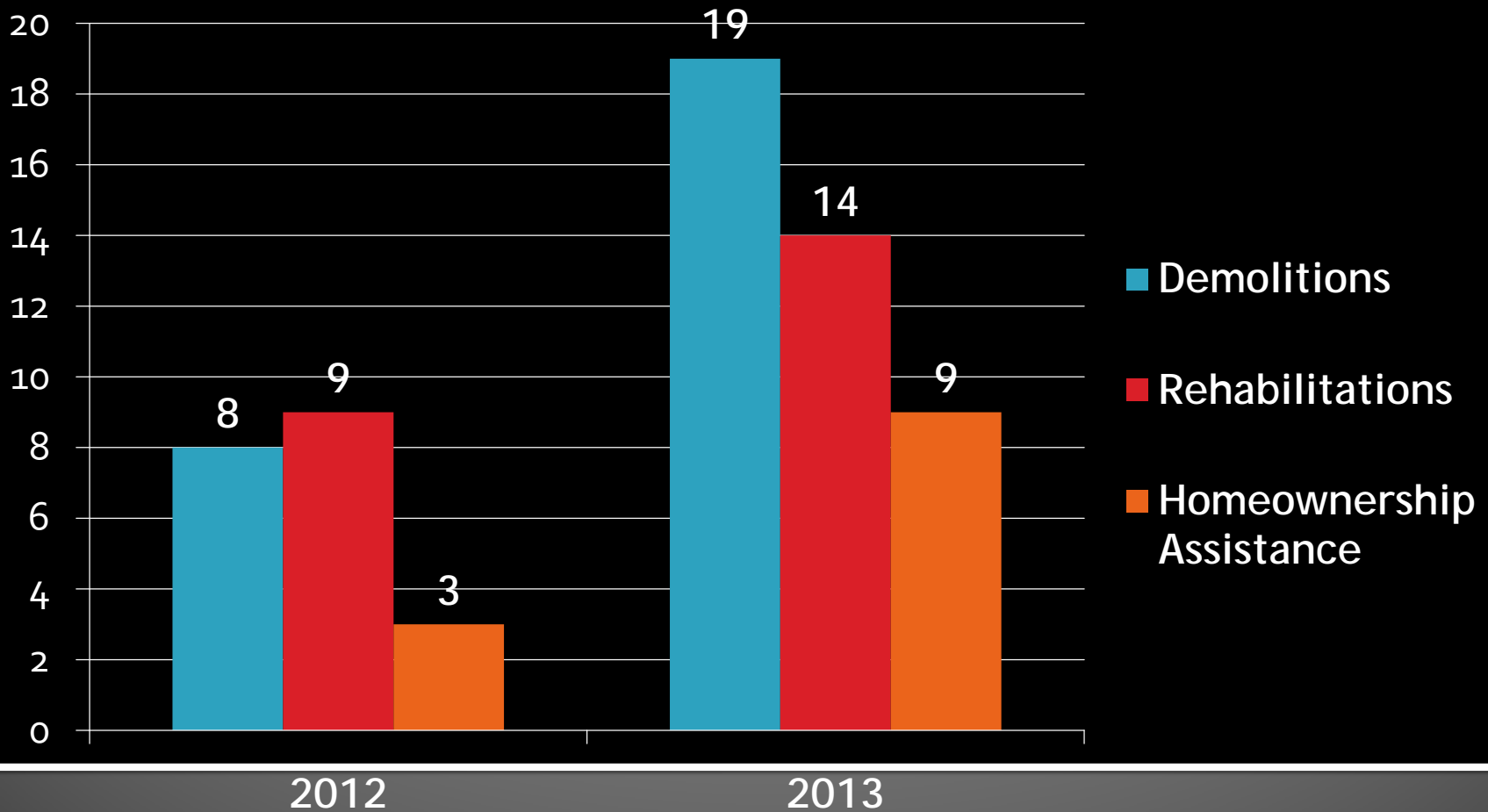

CDBG Homeowner Activities



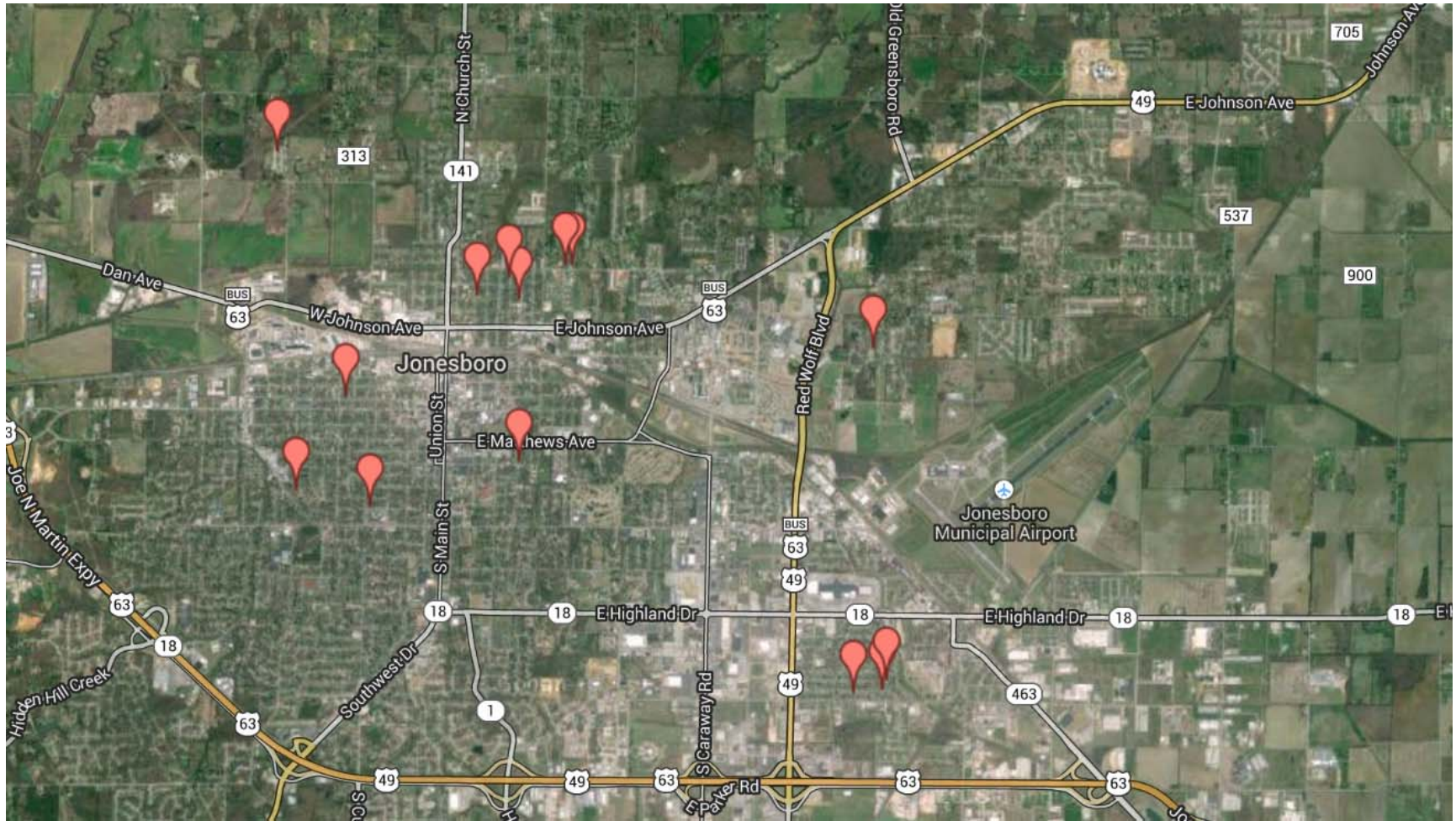
137% increase in demolitions

CDBG Homeowner Rehab Map 2013

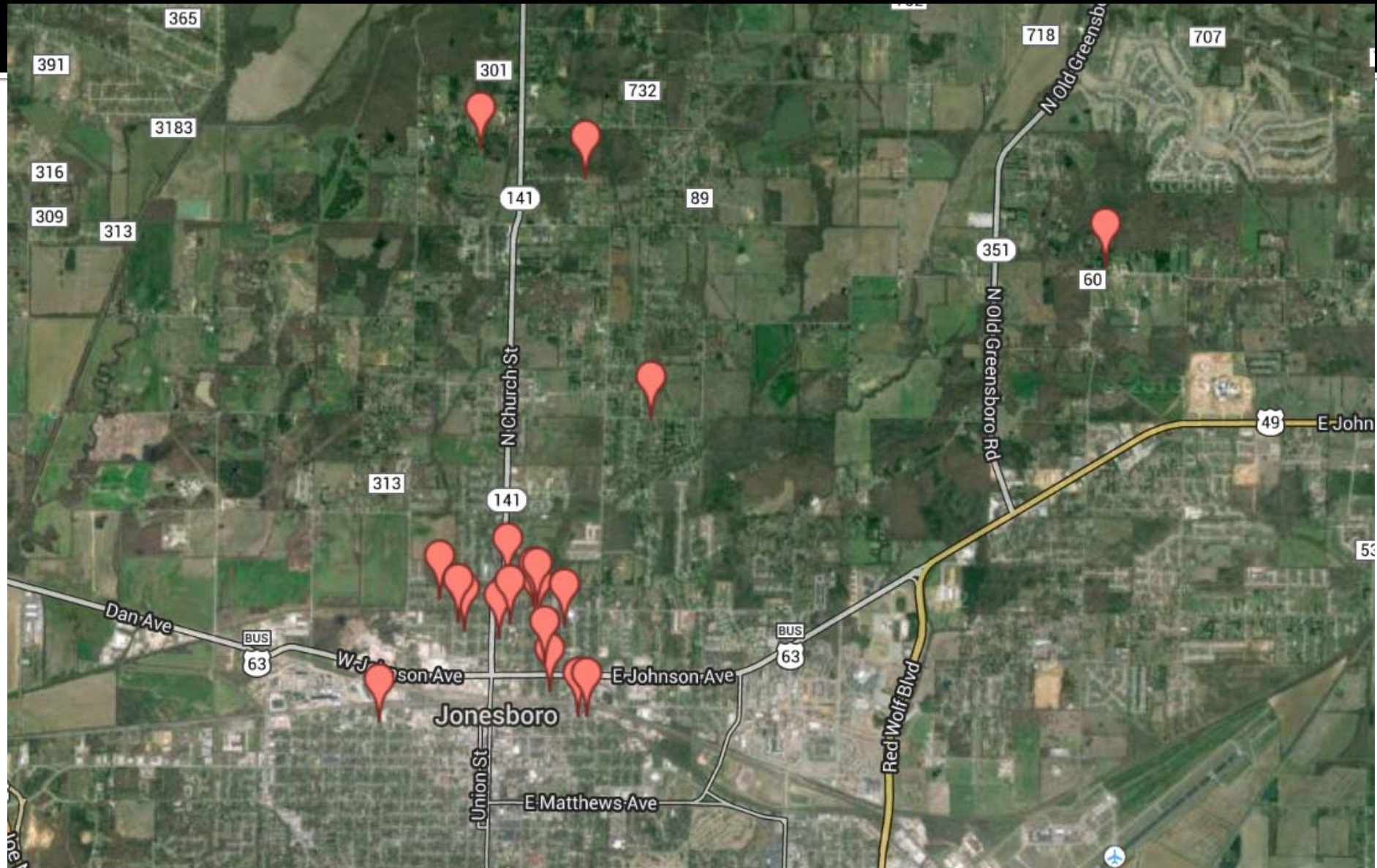


CDBG Funded Demolition Program

NJNI Outcomes

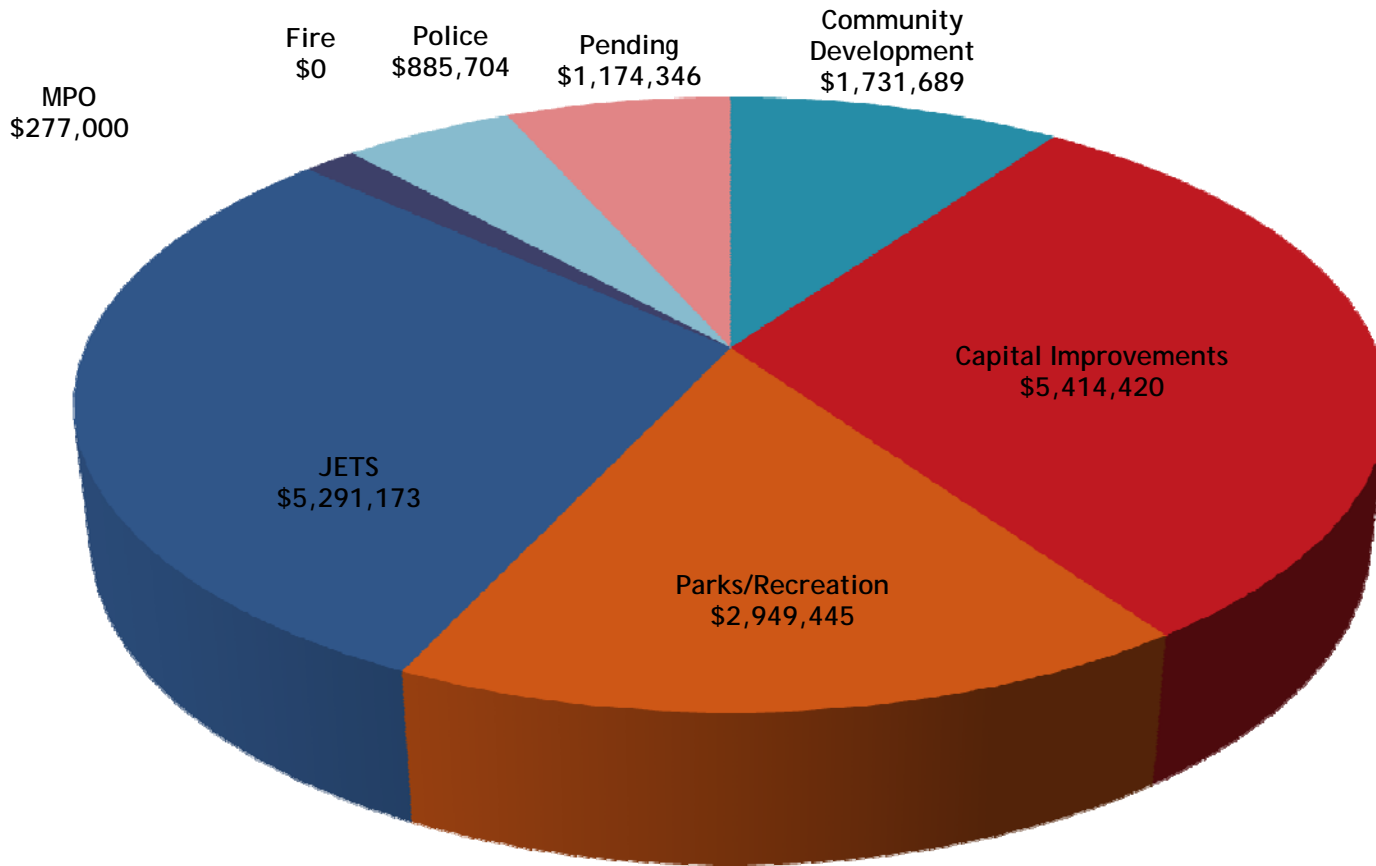
- Volunteers Recruited = 96
- Hours Served = 187
