## ordinance no. 1087

whereas, a petition was duly filed with the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, on the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of Pecamber, 1963, praying the City Council to vacate and abandon an alley described as:

An alley running South from Main Street of Nettleton Station to School Street, located between Lots Thirty-four (34), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36) on the West side, and Lots Nineteen (19), Twenty (20) and Twenty-one (21) on the East side of said alley, in Pardew's Addition to the Town of Nettleton, now Jonesboro, Arkansas,

platted and filed for record in the Recorder's office at Jonesboro,

Arkansas, on the 31st day of August, 1894 , in Record Book 14 ,

page 4 , and

WHEREAS, after due notice as required by law, the City Council has, at the time and place mentioned in the Notice, heard all persons desiring to be heard on the question and has ascertained that the alley or portion thereof, hereinbefore described, has heretofore been dedicated to the public use as an alley herein described; has not been actually used by the public generally for a period of at least five years subsequent to the filing of the plat; that all the owners of property abutting upon the portion of the alley to be vacated above filed with the City Council their written consent to such abandonment; and that public interest and welfare will not be adversely affected by the abandonment of such alley,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas:

Section 1. The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates and abandons all its rights, together with the rights of the public generally in and to the alley designated as follows:

An alley running South from Main Street of Nettleton Station to School Street, located between Lots Thirty-four (34), Thirty-five (35) and Thirty-six (36) on the West side, and Lots Nineteen (19), Twenty (20) and Twenty-One (21) on the East side of said alley, in Pardew's Addition to the Town of Nettleton, now Jonesboro, Arkansas.

Section 2. A copy of the ordinance duly certified by the city clerk shall be filed in the office of the recorder of the Jonesboro District of Craighead County and recorded in the deed records of said county.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force
