- 4. **DISCOUNTS** Show rate, total amount, and latest day any discounts will be allowed after receipt of article and invoice, otherwise City will deduct allowed discount when payment is made.
- 5. FIRM PRICE All prices quoted will remain firm for at least 30 days from date of bid, unless otherwise specified by the City or bidder.

Sound System Recommendations For City Council Chambers.

1. A better speaker system to provide quality sound, even dispersion in listening area and councilmen platform, and most intelligibility of speech possible.

2. Sound System processors needed: Equalizers to provide best fidelity of sound but control feedback. Automatic smart mixers to control mic channel levels by opening when someone speaks into a mic and quickly closes after speech stops. This will eliminate feedback when there is a need many microphones to be used at one time as this venue demands it. The system needs a limiter to limit peaks of operation and protect system from any volume overload.

3. Add six more duplicate microphones to provide all members to have each individual's mic. All microphones need a better mic shockmount base to isolate & eliminate rumble/noise produced by panel's wooden ledge. These shockmount bases will be equiped with lighted- push to mute button.

4. Sound system training of operation, maintance & security; to provide a good knowledge of system to authorized personnel.

WE PROPOSE to furnish labor and material—complete in accordance with above specifications in this proposal.

Payment is to be made as follows: One half upon acceptance of this proposal. The balance is to be paid upon completion of work. Professional Audio maintains one million dollars liability insurance and all equipment is guaranteed to be as specified. 5. The Chamber room has poor acoustics. Sound cannot be controlled well if acoustics are poor. The quality characteristics of sound diminishes as a sound wave travels thru an area; if that area has poor acoustics. This recommendation suggests for room acoustics to be better from existing poor condition: 16- 4' X4' 1" acoustical need to be installed along walls & balcony face.

6. All members of Council, Mayor, Clerk, and City Attorney need better knowlege of sound system, their questions & concerns answered, and a quick in-service training to provide understanding of microphone techniques needed to ensure best sound pickup.

7. Better security for equipment in balcony. Steel locking equipment rack cabinet is recommended.

8. All Media (Cable, TV/Radio personel) shall be provided audio outputs to record Council sessions. But they shall not conduct or demand where or how their audio interface into Council's sound system should be made. The most importance and first priorty is best sound upgraded in Council Chamber, which will allow better media recordings too.

These speakers will be powered by a new proposed power amplifier, installed in existing wooden equipment cabinet in balcony. There shall be two small white speakers facing Council platform so all members can monitor what is being said. These speakers for council platform will be powered by chambers existing best amplifier.

This proposal provides for six more duplicate microphones, and new shockmount bases for all mics. There will be a mic for every person on platform and a mic on the lecturn. The platform will be wired for four new mic line channels to provide enough mic/lines for all members.
