If Fowler Foods, Inc. submits in writing the following conditions to Southwestern Bell and makes them a part of the easement that you are preparing, Southwestern Bell will agree to the closing of the portion of Main Street you have asked for. Those conditions are as follows.


Both of these two statements need to be included in the easement and item number two needs to be put in contract form and signed by Fowler Foods, Inc. and Southwestern Bell.
