CAP6C, 8C, 10C Hydraulic Components and Drivetrain:

CAP6C is a total of 3 years / 8,000 hours, whichever first occurs, for parts and labor on the major hydraulic components and Volvo Construction Equipment Drivetrain components. ~~\$4,840.00~~

Note: When filing warranty claims on machines covered by CAP6C, the mfgc code to be used is "901".

CAP8C is a total of 4 years / 8,000 hours, whichever first occurs, for parts and labor on the major hydraulic components and Volvo Construction Equipment Drivetrain components. ~~\$9,900.00~~

Note: When filing warranty claims on machines covered by CAP8C, the mfgc code to be used is "902".

CAP10C is a total of 5 years / 10,000 hours, whichever first occurs, for parts and labor on the major hydraulic components and Volvo Construction Equipment Drivetrain components. ~~\$18,700.00~~

Note: When filing warranty claims on machines covered by CAP10C, the mfgc code to be used is "903".

Terms and Conditions for Extended Coverage:

- All repairs must be completed with high quality workmanship, safe practices and in an environmentally friendly manner.
- Volvo retains the right to either accept or deny enrollment of any machine into the extended coverage program.
- Volvo retains the right to terminate the terms of any extended coverage due to non-compliance of the terms of the agreement, unsatisfactory maintenance or operation or the use of non-O.E.M. fillers or approved maintenance supplies.
- Volvo retains the right of transfer of the coverage to other than the original purchaser.
- All programs require the enrollment of the machine into the specific program prior to the expiration of the standard warranty or within 60 days of the expiration of the Registered Rental or Plus 6 program and the payment of all applicable fees.
- All programs require the submission of the two most previous machine inspection reports by the selling dealer with any claims of coverage. Failure to provide the reports may nullify the claim of coverage.
- All programs require the submission of the two most previous machine oil sample reports by the selling dealer with any claims of coverage. Failure to provide the reports may nullify the claim of coverage.
- All claimable repairs must be accomplished by an authorized Volvo Dealer factory trained technician in accordance with the practices and procedures defined in the applicable Volvo technical manuals.
- Parts reimbursement coverage on all programs are limited to the parts necessary to make the repair. The use of exchange components to facilitate the repair will be reimbursed for only the repair parts and labor required to repair the failed component.
