

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

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

If you have not read the writings of John Locke, I highly recommend you do so. According to him, passing the property maintenance code without the consent of the people is declaring war on the citizens. Please do not declare war on the residents of Jonesboro. We are a peace-loving people who desire liberty. Hopefully, if it comes to pass, it will be fought with ballots and never with bullets.

Please either drop the code or put it to a public vote on a regular election day where there should be substantial turnout, not a special election where it is anticipated that few except those with a vested interest will vote. I comment the councilman who made such a proposal.

The letter read by four "chiefs" supporting the ordinance was ludicrous. It is interesting to note that one of the signers was the person who brought shame upon the City Council by hiring the mayor's son for a position the morning after the Council created that position without it ever being advertised for applicants.

Despite any good intentions you may have, this ends up being a "rob from the poor, give to the rich" scheme. Consider for example the man who was not physically able to repair his home and lacked money to pay for it to be done. He never did get a straight-forward answer about the consequences he would face as answers seemed to imply he could just ignore any fines imposed and there would be no repercussions. 
To the Mayor and City Council, Jonesboro Arkansas
