8. MAYOR'S REPORTS

Mayor Harold Copenhaver reported on the following:

Since our last city council meeting on December 5, 2024, we have experienced some heartwarming events, but also some sorrow. We lost a member of our city employee family Michael Hottel. Michael Hottel was a long time employee in the Parks & Recreation Department and also on baseball fields at Joe Mack Campbell Sports Complex since March 2017. So, please keep his family and friends and coworkers in your thoughts and prayers. And, obviously, this was Tonya Hottel's nephew. So, it has been a trying time for many people during the holidays.

Josh Hicks was named the December Employee of the Month. He is a senior computer technician in the Information Systems Department. Josh has worked for the city for almost six years. He began as a seasonal part-time employee in the Parks & Recreation Department while a student at ASU-Newport. He graduated with his degree in Information Technology and Josh started with the Information Systems Department and has been a wonderful asset ever since. So, thank you Josh for your commitment to the city and your dedication to helping those around us.

Congratulations to Ronnie Sturch and the E911 Department for being inducted into the nationally recognized Thin Gold Line Foundation supporting 911 dispatchers. Recommended by Wes Holt, due to the 911 peers support groups, our 911 center is the first in Arkansas to be inducted into this foundation. We are grateful for the mental health support of our 911 dispatchers providing the resources they need to be to help keep serving the community. Thin Gold Line Foundation's mission is to raise awareness of mental health in the 911 call taker and emergency dispatcher community. Not just for our community at large, but for our employees, supervisors, and employers. So, Ronnie, thank you very much for your commitment and congratulations to you and your team on that award. Great job.

Meantime, Airport Road, Highway 351 is scheduled for nightly closures which began last night and they go through December 20, 2024. The purpose is to install girders on the railroad overpass on East Nettleton Avenue south of the Jonesboro Municipal Airport.

We mentioned that this might be the last city council meeting so in the last city council meeting so as a reminder we have the holiday patrols throughout the busy holiday season. I hope many of you have seen them. I have. Our goal is to reach 1,000 hours of additional police presence. If you have seen the patrol cars and the solid blue lights turned on, just think of them as extra Christmas lights, right, going through. We appreciate the work that JPD is doing.

Don't forget Christmas at the Park Sunday through Thursday and the final night is Monday, December 23, 2024. This Saturday, December 21st, is Trolley night. Hop on the brand new JET Trolley at Jonesboro Winter Wonderland and take a stop on Madison as they go down to Christmas at the Park. The trolley will take you through the light displays and then will return downtown to keep the fun going at Winter Wonderland. \$5 includes fare admittance to the lights and children under 12 are free.

So, speaking of Parks, Danny, would you like to come forward. I think you might like to make council aware of an award that we received today and I want you to announce it. Parks & Recreation Director Danny Kapales, said, absolutely. I had the pleasure of getting a call from Grants Director Jeremy Biggs. I want to give him some credit because his department actually wrote the grants. So, I am very, very proud of what they did. The Outdoor Recreation grant, the grant that we have unfortunately not received for the last few years, we got that call today that we did receive it. It is \$190,000 grant that is going towards an all inclusive playground being built at Allen Park which is part of the Master Parks Plan, part of the Accelerator Plan. So, that is going to be the first step in that park to make it all inclusive. Basically, the playground will have play equipment similar to the Miracle League. The surface will be similar to the Miracle League and make it where anybody with all different types of needs will be able to get on that playground and play on it. Along with that playground, we are also working towards the splash pad as well. You will be seeing that come in this spring right along with the playground. It's going to get opened up to a point where someone in a wheelchair will be able to access that with no problem whatsoever from the playground. So, it's going to be from the playground itself to the splash pad completely inclusive. One of the really nice things about this grant was that we got to go to down to Little Rock and present and one of the questions that they were asking other folks that were there was do you have a Master Parks Plan and we got to answer yes which was one of the key elements that got us back in the running to get this grant. And, so, this is just one more step. If you want to look at it from a perspective, this \$190,000 already paid for the plan that we put into place. So, thank y'all so much. Mayor Copenhaver said, thank you Danny. I appreciate that. It's good news you bet'cha always moving forward.

On December 6, 2024, we rebranded the Jonesboro Christmas Parade and it was a spectacular success. I want to say thank you to Heather Talley and the Parade Planning Committee for all of their hard work and investment to produce the "Movies on Union" Parade which was a hit. We had about 100 entries. It was also the same time

that we opened Winter Wonderland. So, I want to say thank you, I can't go amiss without saying thank you to the Police, Fire, Streets, Sanitation, Parks & Recreation Departments for your time and effort to help facilitate the event. Without you, it wouldn't be possible.

On December 8, 2024, the Mayor's Youth Council held our Holiday Drop right here in City Hall. We had about 80+ students who are the future of our city and I was happy to have the opportunity to meet their families and offer tours of City Hall. Thank you to the city staff for all of your hard work to host the MYAC for an evening of celebration.

The final neighborhood cleanup was December 7, 2024 at Fox Meadow Elementary School and we hauled in 5.67 tons of trash and 29 tires. The city's neighborhood cleanup totals are for 2024: 106.06 tons of trash and 849 tires collected. That outpaces both 2022 and 2023 years. Thanks to Code Enforcement, Sanitation, and our Keep Jonesboro Beautiful Commission. Our next neighborhood cleanup will be January 11, 2025 with the location to be determined.

I want to say congratulations to Jonesboro Unlimited. We are thrilled to celebrate Jonesboro Unlimited's achievements in securing \$2 million through the Arkansas Site Development Program. The incredible funding was announced by Governor Sarah Huckabee Sanders and the Arkansas Development Commission will provide industrial water service to over 600 acres in the Craighead Technology Park. This investment strengthens Jonesboro's reputation as a center for economic growth and job creation paving the way for exciting new opportunities for our community.

So, in conclusion, I want to remind you that our invitation to join us for our open house meet and greet. It is at City Hall on Thursday, December 19, 2024 from 5:30-7:00 p.m. We will have some appetizers. We will tour City Hall and a little behind the scenes view of what we do here at City Hall.

The last request that I have is item #11 when we get to that. We have a city councilmember that this will be his last meeting. I would love for him to take over at that point and make sure that we adjourn the meeting correctly. Is that alright with you Mitch? Councilmember Mitch Johnson joked, if I can remember how to do that. Mayor Copenhaver said, okay, okay.
