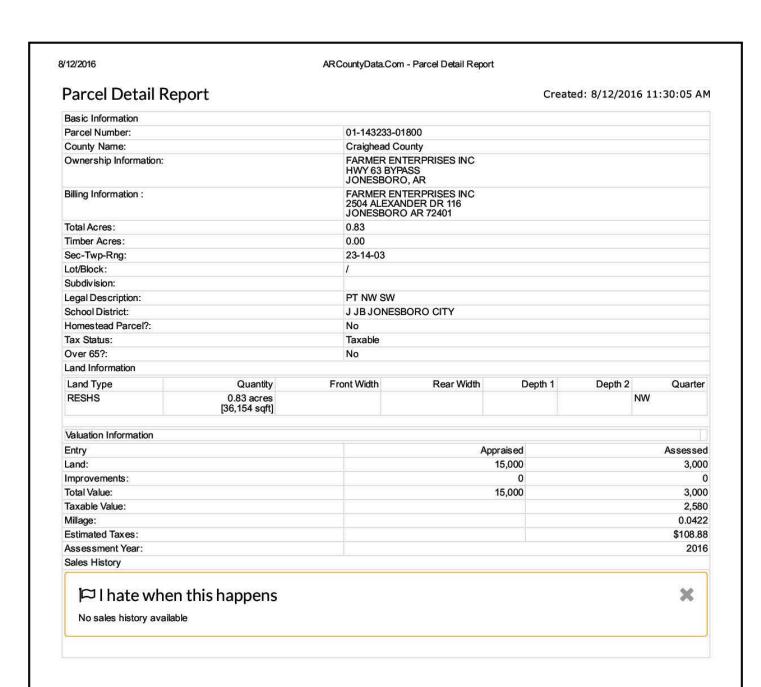
Flood Map

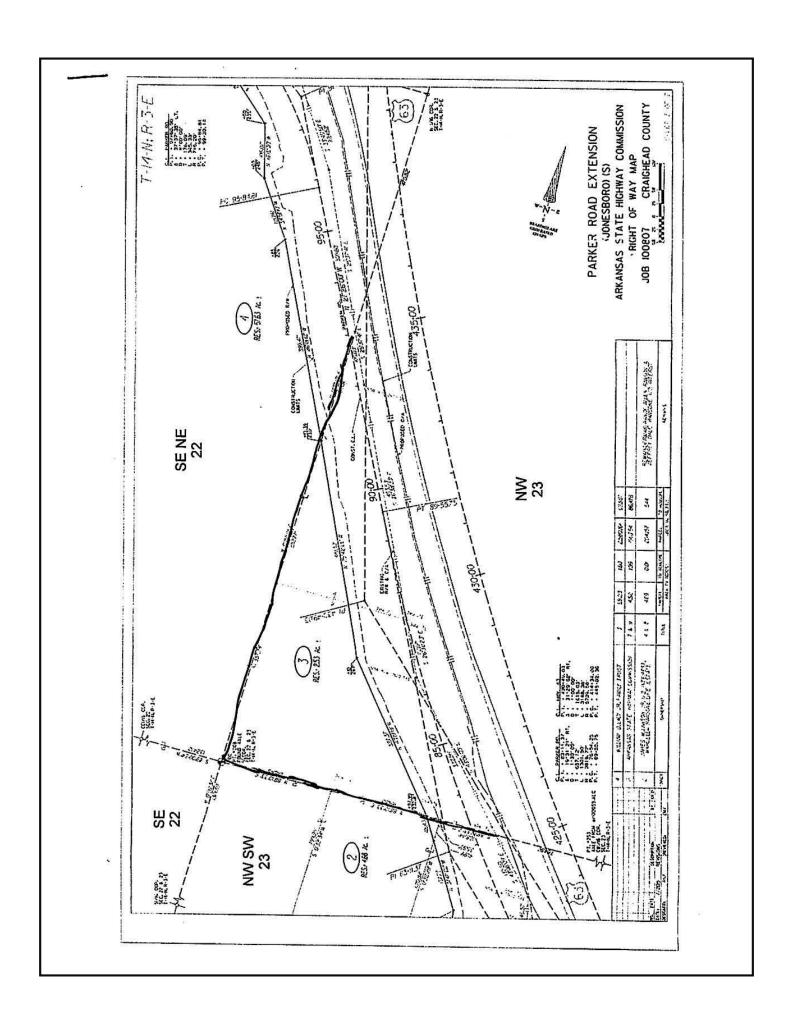
