Appropriation for Purchase of Bud Marshall Property

Since I do not believe we have an existing appropriation, I believe we need to pass an ordinance at the February 2 Council meeting appropriating funds for the purchase of the Bud Marshall property. I would recommend we appropriate \$50,000, as follows:

Purchase of property

\$35,000

Estimated engineering fee

2,500

Title search

110

Estimated utility relocation costs

12,390

Total estimated cost

\$50,000

Should the appropriation be too little, the shortage can be handled through the 2004 budget clean-up ordinance; if it is too much, the money simply will not be expended.

I would further recommend that the appropriation be from the \$3,003,315 December 31, 2003 unappropriated balance of the Capital Improvement Fund.

Enclosed is a recommended appropriations ordinance. If you concur, the ordinance should be forwarded to Donna by the February 2 agenda deadline.
