

ORDINANCE NO. 2208

AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE AND ABANDON A PORTION OF WEST HIGHLAND DRIVE FROM PRESENT ENDING TO BROOKHAVEN ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

SECTION 1: The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates, and abandons all of its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the street designated as follows: "West Highland Drive from present ending to Brookhaven Road."

SECTION 2: A copy of the ordinance duly certified by the City Clerk shall be filed in the office of the Recorder of Craighead County, Arkansas and shall be filed in the Deed Records of such office.

SECTION 3: The City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas finds and declares that the above street and portion of street are not necessary for the general benefit and welfare of the public; that the owners of all the property abutting the above street are in favor of the closure and vacation of the above street and that therefore an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after it's passage and approval.

PASSED AND ADOPTED THIS 21 day of August, 1989 .

ORDINANCE NO. 2299

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2208, FOR CLARIFICATION OF THE DESCRIPTION FOR VACATING AND ABANDONMENT OF A PORTION OF HIGHLAND DRIVE BETWEEN CRESTVIEW STREET AND BROOKHAVEN ROAD.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas:

SECTION 1. That Ordinance No. 2208 is hereby amended to read as follows: The City of Jonesboro, Arkansas, hereby releases, vacates, and abandons all of its rights, together with the rights of the public generally, in and to the street designated as follows: That portion of West Highland Drive beginning at the east property line of Lot 2 of Brookhaven 1st Addition and proceeding west to the eastern right of way line of Brookhaven Road.

SECTION 2. If for any reason any portion of this ordinance is held to be invalid, such invalidity shall in no way affect the remaining portions thereof which are valid, but such valid portions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. It is found and declared by the City Council that an emergency exists and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, shall take effect from and after its passage and approval.
