RE: Conditional Use Permit Application for a Wireless Communication Facility

Dear Mr. Spriggs:

I am an RF engineer for Verizon Wireless. As a part of the above referenced application, you requested evidence that the applicant has made a reasonable and good faith attempt to locate its wireless facility onto an existing structure. The decision to go with this location was made prior to my time in this position as RF Engineer for Central Arkansas. However, from reviewing the candidates that I have access to, the only one that was an existing structure was a Water Tank that was $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile from one of Verizon's existing sites, which is too close. The site that was selected is 1.25 miles away and is more centrally located between Verizon's existing sites.

With respect to the applicant's protocol for periodically monitoring radio frequency emissions and reporting the finding to the city, as a licensee, Verizon Wireless is required by law to perform periodic evaluations to demonstrate continued compliance with FCC guidelines. The site types subjected to these requirements are dependent on specific cell site characteristics as specified by the FCC. Verizon Wireless may provide you with a compliance letter if required.
