ORD-11:012 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 112.7 OF THE JONESBORO MUNICIPAL CODE WITH REGARDS TO SUCCESSIVE PERMIT REQUESTS THAT CUMULATIVELY EXCEED THE EXCEPTION CLAUSE WITHIN A SPECIFIED TIME PERIOD

Sponsors: Stormwater Management Board

City Engineer Craig Light stated this ordinance will allow someone to make an improvement of less than 2,000 square feet, but if they come back within a 3 year period and ask for another improvement of less than 2,000 square feet then the developer will have to bring the site back into compliance. He noted this ordinance is only for site development and storm water management plans, but there is exclusion for industrial and commercial sites that are for improvements of less than 2,000 square feet which will allow the developers not to follow these particular guidelines. He further explained the City has had a few developers that have gotten one permit and then came back and got another one to just avoid the guidelines.

Chairman Street asked if this closes a loophole. Mr. Light answered yes. He further added the City has had only one developer who has expolited the loophole.

ORD-11:013 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9.1 OF THE STORMWATER DRAINAGE DESIGN MANUAL WITH REGARDS TO SUCCESSIVE PERMIT REQUESTS THAT CUMULATIVELY CONSTITUTE A SUBSTANTIAL IMPROVEMENT TO A STRUCTURE IN A SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD AREA
