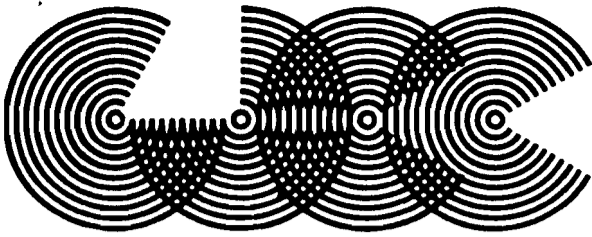

Please accept this letter as a commitment from the Greater Jonesboro Chamber of Commerce regarding our participation in the Bypass Beautification project.

As you well know this project was developed by the Beautification Committee of the Chamber and we are dedicated to the completion of the project.

Phase 1 of this project includes the interchanges at Commerce Drive and Stadium Blvd. and everything between.
