I am in receipt of your letter of August 18, 2023, regarding this matter. We have reviewed your letter with our client and the executor is unable to accept your offer. Pursuant to Arkansas law in the administration of Ms. Croft's Estate, the property must be sold for at least the appraised value of the real property. The Craighead County Assessor has appraised the property located on lots 20 and 21 (the land and improvements) for \$43,540.00 and the property located on lots 22, 23 and 24 for \$5,000.00. As you are aware, the values assessed by the Assessor are typically below market value.

Our client will accept the sum of \$65,000.00 for the five (5) lots subject to the approval of the Probate Court in the administration of Ms. Croft's Estate. If this is acceptable, I can prepare a real estate purchase agreement for review and execution. We would then petition the Probate Court to sell the real property in accordance with the real estate purchase agreement.
