At present, all elementary schools are controlled by stop signs, one way streets, or yellow caution lights, except Fox Meadow Elementary. If the city will furnish "double face" stop signs, or signs placed together to show STOP on both sides, school authorities will have them placed at the cross walks each morning and afternoon during school traffic hours. By having them do this, traffic will not be delayed or stopped except for a short period of time in the morning or afternoon during school hours only. Mr. Al Fisher of the school, said that the school will mount the signs for us, on a portable stanchion (pole), and move them each morning and afternoon. Signs of some type are needed here. By handling the problem in this manner, the problem may be solved without heavily regulating traffic. Signs will be used only when school is in session.
