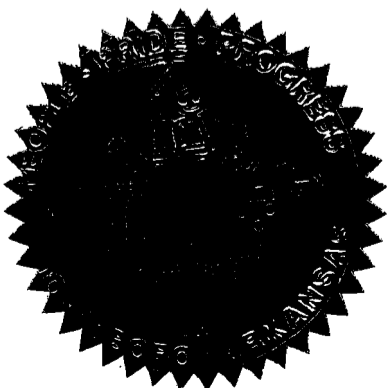
PROCLAMATION
