WHEREAS, the City of Jonesboro has desires to accept the low bid and enter into a contract for the Rail Maintenance and Road Crossing Signal Testing and Maintenance - Job No. 2009:38;

WHEREAS, the low bidder and the firm selected for the Rail Maintenance and Road Crossing Signal Testing and Maintenance - Job No. 2009:38 is Prewett Enterprises, Inc. dba B & P Enterprises;

WHEREAS, Prewett Enterprises, Inc. dba B & P Enterprises has bid \$13,195.00 for “one time” work of realigning and tie replacement and \$50,400.00 for the yearly cost for inspections for the Rail Maintenance and Road Crossing Signal Testing and Maintenance - Job. No. 2009:38;

WHEREAS, the funding for the execution of the contract shall come from 07-100-0180-00 and compensation shall be paid in accordance with the contract documents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS THAT:

Section 1. That the City of Jonesboro shall accept the low bid and enter into a contract with Prewett Enterprises, Inc. dba B & P Enterprises in the amount of bid \$13,195.00 for “one time” work of realigning and tie replacement and \$50,400.00 for the yearly cost for inspections for the Rail Maintenance and Road Crossing Signal Testing and Maintenance - Job. No. 2009:38

Section 2. The funding for the execution of the contract shall come from 07-100-0180-00 and compensation shall be paid in accordance with the contract documents

Section 3. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized by the City Council for the City of Jonesboro to execute all documents necessary to effectuate this agreement.
