THE ENTIRE ELECTRICAL SYSTEM MUST BE INSPECTED, REPAIRED, AND BROUGHT UP TO CURRENT CODE. THE ROOF OF THE HOME IS SAGGING AND BULGING. ALL RAFTERS NEED TO BE CLOSELY INSPECTED THEN REPAIRED OR REPLACED. ALL UNDERLAY AND SHINGLES NEED REPLACED. THE SOFFIT ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE HOME IS COMPLETELY GONE AND MUST BE REPLACED. ALL WINDOWS AND DOORS ARE EITHER BROKEN OR BOARDED. THE HOME IS A HAZARD TO THE HEALTH, WELFARE, AND SAFETY OF THE PUBLIC. THE HOME SHOULD BE RAZED IMMEDIATELY TO ENSURE THE SAFETY OF LOCAL CHILDREN AND OTHER CITIZENS, NOT TO MENTION THE BLIGHT TO THE COMMUNITY. PROPERTY WAS SECURED AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.
