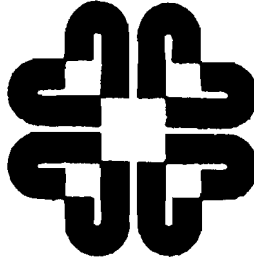

Dear Joe;

On April 16, 1985 Asst. Chief Cook, Capt. Dowdy and Capt. Smith of this department and Tim Ray of your department inspected the site plans and made a personal visit to the proposed Chelsea Heights sub-division. We were looking at the location in respect to concerns brought to our attention about the possibility of traffic hazards that could exist with the existing plans. The areas we looked at were the proposed road coming from the sub-division and linking up with Airport road and also the driveways that would exit onto Airport road.

The proposed road coming out onto Airport road between Vickie and Pamela could have some possible problems with visibility if cars parking in the driveways did so in a manner that would obstruct the vision. It is our understanding also that the autos exiting the driveways of the houses that front Airport road would have to back out onto Airport road. If this be the case it could cause some problems due to the speed of traffic on Airport road.

These are the only things we found to report on upon our inspection of the above areas.
