

PETITION FOR ABANDONMENT OF STREETS

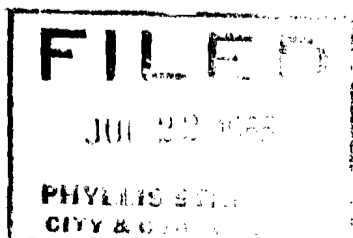
Comes the undersigned Nettleton-Phillips Consolidated School by its President H. C. Kiech and Secretary J. A. Williams and Harley Keich, being all of the abutting property owners concerned, petition to the City Council of the City of Jonesboro Arkansas, and hereby request and consent to the passage of an ordinance after the notice as required by law, providing for the vacating and abandonment of a portion of Leroy Street and Dudley Street in Dudley Subdivision of a part of Blocks B, C, D, E, F, and G of Dudley's first addition to the town of Nettleton, Arkansas, (now Jonesboro, Arkansas) as hereinafter set out.

- (1) That portion of Leroy Street beginning at James Street and running West to Dudley Avenue.
- (2) That portion of Dudley Avenue beginning at Oliver Street and running North to a point parallel to the North line of Lots 5, 6, 7, and 8 of Block B of said subdivision:

Petitioners state that even though said streets are shown on a plat filed herewith and recorded, that said streets have never been used by the public as a street or alley for a period of five years, in fact said portion of said streets have never been open.

WHEREFORE petitioners request that the City Council for the City of Jonesboro, Arkansas fix a date for the hearing of this petition and direct the City Clerk to give notice of said hearing and date by publication once a week for two consecutive weeks in the Jonesboro Sun; the notice to state the names of the persons who signed the petition and identify the streets proposed to be vacated.
