Councilmember LJ Bryant asked, Chairman, can someone give us a rundown from the administration. E911 Director Ronnie Sturch said, I will try. Thank you so much. As it was said in the ordinance, one of the things as you are well aware, the 911 systems and center, technologies have just exploded and have moved so fast that one of the things that we identified was our addresses are way out of, they are obsolete, they are way out of line with the new systems we use. There have been several of the city departments that have worked on this and we have come with what we think is a great standard to move forward with that will hopefully move us forward for several years. I'll be glad to entertain any specific questions. Councilmember Janice Porter said, I have some questions. Yes, in existing neighborhoods where the street signs are out of compliance, who bears the financial responsibility for replacing those? Mr. Sturch said, the existing, the way that I understand the way that the standard is written, the existing would be, I think the city would bear the responsibility on that. Councilmember Porter said, thank you. And, have you identified suppliers who are going to manufacture those address number signs so that the public can know how to go about getting them? Councilmember David McClain said, I don't know if this is an error, but it says City of Walnut Ridge. Chairman Johnson said, I didn't print that report off for once so I did not see that. Councilmember McClain said, it says City of Walnut Ridge for 2022. I don't think that is accurate. Chairman Johnson said, I usually print off the report so I can look at the light traps, but I didn't do it this month. Councilmember McClain said, it wouldn't be right. Chairman Johnson said, no, it sure wouldn't would it. Is that just a cover on that? Councilmember McClain said, no, it has Walnut Ridge 2022. Councilmember Chris Moore said, they are sending that for comparison David. Chairman Johnson said, maybe so. Councilmember Moore said, maybe we ought to look at that and see how it is going right up in the middle of the rice fields. Chairman Johnson said, I will call Jim and ask him to get something sent to us and see if we can't get it sent out to committee to review. Councilmember McClain said, also, I was going to ask do we have a report from ASU with the results and what they were from their study? I know I was called and notified how many mosquitoes are around my house, but I didn't know if they were doing further research to tell us these are the types and this is how we treat them and what the plan was beyond that. Chairman Johnson said, I have not been in touch with anybody from ASU that's participating in that program at this time. City Attorney Carol Duncan said, I will say that my understanding from just talking to the people who came to my backyard is that you treat them all the same. It doesn't matter what breed they are. That's what they told me. Councilmember Brian Emison said, I will say in addition that I got a telephone call even as recently as last week to report on my trap that they put in my yard. So, apparently, it is still, the study is still ongoing. Ms. Duncan said, they are still collecting. Chairman Johnson said, so, for you guys that are putting traps in your yard, are they telling you any variety or are they just ...? Ms. Duncan said, they said they will report that later, but I haven't gotten that report. I think it takes a while. There were 222 mosquitoes in my backyard in one night. It seemed like a lot to me. Chairman Johnson said, well, the only thing that kind of made me curious about overall is that Vector had just said that we had three different varieties and then the people from ASU mentioned several other varieties that were here. So, I was wanting to kind of see what the comparison might be there. Ms. Duncan said, the report you get from them says that you will get a further report telling you which kinds, but that it would take a while for them to collect that data out of it. City Clerk April Leggett said, they are a small group. Ms. Duncan said, there's like five of them that are doing all of this work. Chairman Johnson said, they would have to count them and pick at them with tweezers. Brian, do you have some insight on this? Chief Administrative Officer Brian Richardson said, yes, I was just going to add that it is my understanding that they are going to kind of collect all this data and they are going to come back here and do an end-of-mosquito season and wrap up about their findings and then kind of what their next steps are as far as their data analytics and possible treatment options that they see that might be worthwhile exploring. I guess the most important part is to learn exactly the makeup of the nemesis that we face and move forward with any logical treatment options that might exist. I look forward to hearing about that. Chairman Johnson said, while you are there, I can say that I haven't noticed the plane fly, but one time. So, I'm pretty disappointed in our flyover service this season for sure. Mr. Richardson said, we will get that information about the plane routes and we will have that resent out. I didn't notice the reports thing until that was pointed out. Councilmember LJ Bryant said, maybe they sent the plane to Walnut Ridge. Mr. Richardson said, that is possible. Walnut Ridge has got some great mosquito treatment this month. Chairman Johnson said, that plane has a pretty distinctive sound, but I have only heard it one time and I can't remember what night it was. Ms. Leggett stated, I believe Ryan Vaughn had some little thing that you could see it,

AN ORDINANCE INCREASING THE DEATH BENEFIT AMOUNT PAYABLE TO AN ELIGIBLE SURVIVOR OF A DECEASED MEMBER OF THE JONESBORO LOCAL POLICE PENSION FUND

WHEREAS the City Council authorizes an increase in the current death benefit amount under Arkansas Code Annotated 24-11-430 of sixty-five hundred dollars (\$6,500.00) to ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to an eligible survivor of the JONESBORO Local Police Pension Fund. This increased amount shall be payable only to the survivor of a retired member who passed away on or after September 1, 2024, and under the administrative procedures of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council recognizes that the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System (LOPFI) is the administrator of the JONESBORO Local Police Pension Fund (Local Plan). Therefore, the Chief Administrative Officer is hereby authorized to provide LOPFI an official copy of this approved Ordinance authorizing the increased death benefit amount of \$10,000 (gross amount) as a benefit provision for this Local Plan.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> It is the intent of the City Council and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this Ordinance shall be codified into the Code of Ordinances of JONESBORO, Arkansas and the sections thereof may be re-numbered and re-lettered as necessary to accomplish such intention.

<u>SECTION 3.</u> Due to the need to meet the deadline set by LOPFI to implement this increase for the local law enforcement plan, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force from and after the date of its passage and approval.

Dear Mr. Purtee:

This is regarding the City of Jonesboro's proposed increase in the amount of the death benefit for its Local Police Plan (Local Plan). This specific provision is found in ACA 24-11-430 and applies to all members of the Local Plan.

Based on the city's request, an actuarial valuation was completed. The enclosed valuation provides the <u>revised</u> monthly Local Plan employer contribution rate to implement this change. The revised rate that will be used through 2025 is:

• Increase death benefit from the current \$6,500 to \$10,000: \$20,332/month. This is an increase of \$531 per month in the Local Plan employer contribution rate.

To assist with implementing this increase, enclosed is a draft ordinance that you are welcome to use when presenting this topic to the city council. If the city council does approve the increase, please provide LOPFI with a copy of the approved ordinance and draft minutes from that meeting, so that LOPFI can implement this benefit change. It is important to keep in mind that the valuation expires October 31, 2024, so LOPFI must receive the approved ordinance and draft minutes by the October 31st date to use the results in this valuation. And to help facilitate the timely receipt of these documents, you are welcome to email them to me in lieu of mailing hardcopies.

As requested, we have determined the expected increase in the employer contribution rate that would result from increasing the current death benefit from \$6,500 to \$10,000 for a retired member who passes away on or after September 1, 2024.

The date of the study was as of December 31, 2023. This supplemental valuation does not predict the result of the December 31, 2024 valuation or of any other future actuarial valuation. (Future activities can affect future valuation results in an unpredictable manner.) Rather, the supplemental valuation gives an indication of the probable effect of the proposed changes on future valuations without comment on the complete end result of the future valuations.

This report is intended to describe the financial effect of the proposed plan changes. Except as otherwise noted, potential effects on other benefit plans were not considered. No statement in this report is intended to be interpreted as a recommendation in favor of the changes, or in opposition to them. GRS is not responsible for unauthorized use of this report.

In the event that more than one plan change is being considered, it is very important to remember that the results of separate actuarial valuations cannot generally be added together to produce a correct estimate of the combined effect of all of the changes. The total can be considerably greater than the sum of the parts due to the interaction of various plan provisions with each other, and with the assumptions that must be used.

In accordance with LOPFI Board policy, the employer contribution rates established by this valuation report are valid for purposes of approving the benefit changes until October 31, 2024.

Heidi G. Barry and Casey T. Ahlbrandt-Rains are Members of the American Academy of Actuaries (MAAA) and meet the Qualification Standards of the American Academy of Actuaries required to render the actuarial opinions contained herein.



Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System Supplemental Actuarial Valuation – Jonesboro Local Police as of December 31, 2023

This report was prepared using our proprietary valuation model and related software which, in our professional judgment, has the capability to provide results that are consistent with the purposes of the valuation and has no material limitations or known weaknesses. We performed tests to ensure that the model reasonably represents that which is intended to be modeled.

The actuarial methods and assumptions were the same as those used in the regular valuation as of December 31, 2023. In particular, the economic assumptions used in the supplemental actuarial valuation were net investment return of 7.25% per year and wage inflation of 3.00% per year.

A brief summary of the benefit recipient data used for the purposes of the study as of December 31, 2023 is presented below:

The home is on a pier foundation. The roof has some sagging and waving. All rafters need closely inspected and any damaged rafters, underlay, and shingles must be repaired or replaced. All windows and doors are currently boarded. The home has been boarded well over the 6-month limit set in Jonesboro city ordinance. The interior of the home is destroyed. 



City of Jonesboro Activity Report

July 2024

Vector Disease Control, Inc. (VDCI) provides a proven, scientific approach to mosquito control for the City of Jonesboro. VDCI's operations include larval and adult mosquito surveillance followed by the application of larvicides and adulticides.

Mosquito Surveillance

VDCI has utilized a total of (13) New Jersey light traps placed in residential and recreational areas throughout Jonesboro. These traps collected an average of 13.88 mosquitoes per trap night (5,054) total mosquitoes during this time. There have been a total of 3 mosquito species collected.

Larval Control Activity

Permanent water, flood water, artificial containers, and drainage system sites are inspected for larval mosquito breeding on a regular basis. In total, 49 sites were inspected with 18 sites having mosquito larvae present. As a result of these inspections, 1,360.00 ounces of granular BTI (VectoBacG) was applied to these mosquito breeding sites. Additionally, VDCI is continuing to eliminate breeding habitat for artificial container mosquitoes by targeting bird baths, buckets, tires etc.

In response to community events and mosquito surveillance data, VDCI applied the adulticide on 53 truck routes for this reporting period. All adulticide ULV applications were made with truck-mounted ULV units equipped with GPS-enabled monitors. During this report period, a total of 1,965.2 spray miles and 71,454.30 acres were treated with a total of 416 gallons of adulticide in residential and recreational areas. In addition to routine truck spraying, VDCI has responded to 53 service requests and adulticided all

VDCI performed 1 aerial spraying during this reporting period. A total of 120.0 gallons of chemical was dispensed treating a total of 23,273.0 acres.

Throughout this reporting period, VDCI has continued to provide exceptional control of larval and adult mosquito populations. VDCI will remain diligent in our surveillance and control activities to prevent a significant increase in the mosquito population. 



City of Jonesboro Activity Report

August 2024

Vector Disease Control, Inc. (VDCI) provides a proven, scientific approach to mosquito control for the City of Jonesboro. VDCI's operations include larval and adult mosquito surveillance followed by the application of larvicides and adulticides.

Mosquito Surveillance

VDCI has utilized a total of (13) New Jersey light traps placed in residential and recreational areas throughout Jonesboro. These traps collected an average of 7.34 mosquitoes per trap night (1,303) total mosquitoes during this time. There have been a total of 3 mosquito species collected.

Larval Control Activity

Permanent water, flood water, artificial containers, and drainage system sites are inspected for larval mosquito breeding on a regular basis. In total, 12 sites were inspected with 4 sites having mosquito larvae present. As a result of these inspections, 168.00 ounces of granular BTI (VectoBacG) was applied to these mosquito breeding sites. Additionally, VDCI is continuing to eliminate breeding habitat for artificial container mosquitoes by targeting bird baths, buckets, tires etc.

Adult Mosquito Control Activity











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In response to community events and mosquito surveillance data, VDCI applied the adulticide on 32 truck routes for this reporting period. All adulticide ULV applications were made with truck-mounted ULV units equipped with GPS-enabled monitors. During this report period, a total of 1,145.4 spray miles and 41,645.3 acres were treated with a total of 258 gallons of adulticide in residential and recreational areas. In addition to routine truck spraying, VDCI has responded to 23 service requests and adulticided all parks, and any special events during the month.

VDCI performed 2 aerial spraying during this reporting period. A total of 114.0 gallons of chemical was dispensed treating a total of 22,109 acres.

Summary

Throughout this reporting period, VDCI has continued to provide exceptional control of larval and adult mosquito populations. VDCI will remain diligent in our surveillance and control activities to prevent a significant increase in the mosquito population. If VDCI detects a significant rise in the mosquito population we will increase larval and adult control. 


