Councilman Mikel Fears stated he received some calls from some Property Owners Associations and citizens concerning parking on the street and was wondering if this will allow the Property Owners Associations to put signs up in their neighborhoods. Chief Yates answered it will not apply to the Property Owners Associations, but the City could put up the signs if need be. He noted enforcing this ordinance will be primarily complaint driven. He added the City can ask the person to move the vehicle and if that doesn't work then a citation could be given, but as long as the obstruction requirement is met then it would be covered by this ordinance.

Discussion was held concerning parking in residential areas.

Chief Yates explained one of the most common complaints the City receives is people walking in the street and obstructing traffic. He added there is a requirement in this ordinance that states when a sidewalk is available you have to use the sidewalk.

Councilman Chris Moore asked if this just needs to be reviewed or placed on the Council agenda. Chairman Johnson answered that it can be placed on the Council agenda, but have 3 different readings so if this ordinance needs reworded then it could be.

A motion was made by Councilman Mikel Fears, seconded by Councilman Chris Moore, that this matter be Recommended to Council . The motion PASSED by a unanimous vote
