## 8. MAYOR'S REPORTS

Mayor Perrin informed the Council he and City Engineer Craig Light will be traveling to Memphis this week in order to start the project with the Corps of Engineers. He added the City received \$130,000 grant for the project. He stated they have a lot of data that will help with the in-kind contribution.

Mayor Perrin stated Legislative Audit is still at City Hall, but he anticipates an exit interview within the next two to three weeks. He also stated there will be another public hearing regarding the Master Land Use Plan and the Planning Department is continuing to compile information for the plan.

He explained the Engineering and Street Departments have over 846 work orders stacked up because the City hasn't been in the field much over the past few years. He further explained he is working with Mr. Light and Street Superintendent Floyd Lemm to improve the turnover rate so they can respond in 24 hours.

Mayor Perrin stated they met with Ms. Karen Bassett from ADEQ concerning the landfill. He stated he hopes the City will authorize the purchase of an incinerator in order to get limbs and other debris cleaned up at the landfill.

Mayor Perrin announced a ribbon cutting ceremony for Highway 67 at Newport on October 15, 2009, at 9:00 a.m. He noted they have all been invited to attend the ceremony and encouraged everyone to attend.

He noted the street overlays have been delayed due to the weather, but will commence again next week. He also stated FTN is working on the landfill closure and should have it in final stages within 30 days.

Mayor Perrin explained 61 workers from the Mississippi County Correctional Unit will be working to clean up ditches, including Turtle Creek. He further explained they hope to use the workers every week or every other week.

Mayor Perrin informed the Council they have identified three pieces of property that the City owns that it has no use for at this time. He stated they hope to put together an ad for the Jonesboro Sun to publish this weekend asking for bids for the properties. He identified the properties as being the old fire station on the corner of Matthews and Caraway, the 85 acres the City purchased on Strawfloor and 8 acres on Ely Walker in the Industrial Park. He noted all of the properties have been appraised.

Lastly, Mayor Perrin commended CDBG for the revitalization meeting at Allen Park. He noted the plan is in infancy and needs to be put in action.
