# Ordinances To Be Introduced

# ORD-10:039

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2010 ANNUAL BUDGET AND THE CITY SALARY & ADMINISTRATION PLAN FOR THE CITY OF JONESBORO TO ADD AN ADDITIONAL CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICER TO THE INSPECTIONS DEPARTMENT

**Sponsors:** Community Development, Human Resources and Code Enforcement

Mayor Perrin explained the position will be 100% funded with CDBG grants. Councilman Hargis noted the position will be supervised by Chief Building Inspector Terry Adams. Councilman Dover questioned whether the position can be reapplied for every year so the position will continue to be paid for with CDBG funds and will not have to be paid by the City in the future. Mayor Perrin answered yes. Grants Administrator Gayle Vickers noted the position will be used in their specific areas and will be completely federally funded. She added she will be working with Mr. Adams regarding the position and they will have weekly reports. She explained 100% of the position's time has to be in the CDBG area. Councilman Hargis questioned how she defines what the CDBG area is. Ms. Vickers stated HUD has defined what the scope of work can be. She further explained she worked with Mr. Adams to define specific streets in the City that the position will be able to work on. Councilman Hargis then questioned what the CDBG areas are. Ms. Vickers stated they are defined by census tracts based on income. She noted the maps are located at her office.

#### ORD-10:040

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE 2010 BUDGET OF THE CITY OF JONESBORO, ARKANSAS TO PROVIDE FOR ADDITIONAL COSTS OF UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE

**Sponsors:** Finance

City Treasurer Jim Eagan explained the money the City paid for 2009 unemployment insurance claims was less than what the City ended up owing. He further explained they make quarterly payments, but then found out the actual cost was more than they had anticipated. Mayor Perrin stated they will do a better job of estimating the payments. He noted unemployment can now go up to 24 months, which increases the amount of unemployment claims the City will have to pay. He also added only one person that was terminated in 2009 is included in the claims.

Financial reports

Mayor Perrin stated they were unable to provide more financial reports because they are in the process of changing the formats of the reports. He added he will be able to provide those reports via email before Friday. He then discussed the hotel/motel tax report and noted there is one hotel that has not paid in several months. He stated they sent a demand letter to the hotel, as well as to their home office in Forrest City. He also noted the tax has increased since February, partially due to tournaments being played in the City. He discussed the alcoholic beverage report and stated the tax has decreased since February.

#### Discussion concerning CDBG

Councilman Hargis discussed CDBG and how the funds are spent. Ms. Vickers stated the guidelines are federally mandated, so she has no control over them. She explained the federal government tells them what areas they can serve and what they can do with the funds. Further discussion was held concerning CDBG guidelines. Ms. Vickers reiterated the areas are based on census tracts and income. She further explained areas have to be designated as benefit areas for them to receive assistance. She added they also have homeowner rehabilitation programs, as well as new home ownership programs, for individual benefits.
