- 1. Intersection of Asbury Dr. @ Grayson Dr. Stop sign should be placed in the northwest corner stopping southbound traffic on Asbury Dr.

Alderman Moore,

I have received a request from Radius Baker, superintendent of the Valley View school system, to designate Kelsey Cove One-Way (traffic flow east to west) between the hours of 7:00am-9:00am and 2:00pm-4:00pm when school is in session. Kelsey Cove is a narrow street that accommodates both car and bus traffic that ends at a gated entrance to the rear drive of the Valley View campus. During the time of the One-Way period, traffic will be routed around the paved road behind the school and will exit onto Valley View Drive. There is only one residential house on Kelsey Cove. Limited traffic flow around schools increase safety for the students as well as makes the area less congested during high volume times, therefore after viewing this area I make the recommendation to make the change as listed above.
