



CITY COUNCIL MINUTES – April 4, 2006

The Jonesboro City Council met Monday, April 4, 2007, at 3:00 p.m. for a special called meeting. Members present were: Mayor Doug Formon, City Clerk, Donna K. Jackson, City Attorney Crego and seven council members. Those members were: Province, Hargis, Perrin, Street, Dover, Furr, and Councilwoman McCall.

City Attorney Crego read the following ordinance for the third and final reading:

ORDINANCE TO REZONE PROPERTY FROM RESIDENTIAL R-1 TO COMMERCIAL C-4 LIMITED USE OVERLAY, LOCATED ON HIGHLAND DRIVE BETWEEN WOFFORD AND RAINS. (First Financial Bank)

Councilman Perrin moved, seconded by Councilman Dover for the adoption of the ordinance. Attorney Don Parker, representing First Financial Bank, had submitted his original ordinance which did not contain provisions for the Limited Use Overlay and the installation of a cul-de-sac. The day of the City Council meeting on March 20th Attorney Parker provided a revised ordinance, however the original ordinance was read, instead of the revision. The purpose of the special called meeting was to have the third and final reading of the revised ordinance. A voice vote was taken resulting in all members voting aye. Those members were: Province, Hargis, Perrin, Street, Dover, Furr, and Councilwoman McCall. The ordinance was assigned number 34-2007.

With no further business, Councilman Dover moved, seconded by Councilwoman McCall, to adjourn the meeting. A voice vote was taken resulting in all members voting aye. Those members were: Farmer, Province, Hargis, Williams, Perrin, Street, Dover, Furr, McCall and Ashley
