A search was made in the subject market area for sales comparable to our subject. The majority of sales are purchased for the purpose of expanding St. Bernards Hospital medical services. The location of such site is determined by the specific use the hospital may intend and the ability to assemble such. They range in zoning from R-2 (multi-family) to C-5 (commercial). Sales range in age from July 2005 to October 2008. They range in price per square foot from \$1.73 to \$2.77. Given a lack of recent sales, a time adjustment was not justified. All sales were in similar size and locations. The mean (average) of all sales is \$2.41/st, while the median is \$2.60/sf. Given the above sales, the estimated value of our subject is \$2.50/sf.

Therefore, \$2.50 x 6004 sf = \$15,010. Rounded \$15,000

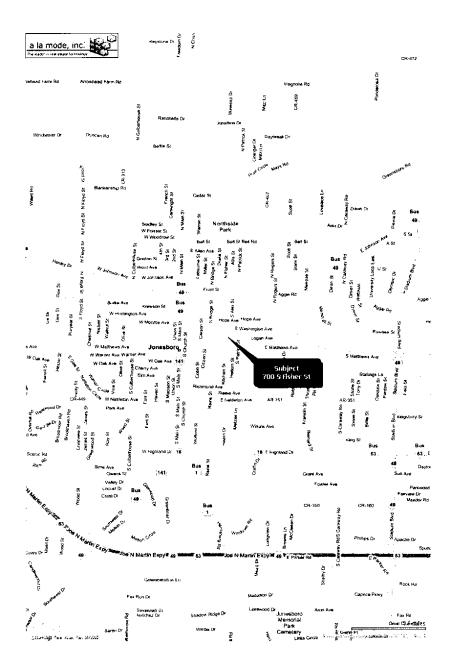
