Construction Specifications for Shaping Existing Channel

100.1 Description. This item shall consist of modifying the existing channel to conform substantially to the original typical section. This work shall include clearing and grubbing, excavating and hauling or drifting material necessary in widening the existing channel, making minor cuts and fills, and/or shaping and dressing the bottom of the channel and slopes to provide a uniform and well-drained channel. The placement of Rip Rap on Projects #1 and #5 ONLY.

100.02 Construction Requirements. Material obtained from shaping the bottom of the channel shall be spread on the slopes or on the adjacent spoil pile berms in the case of Projects #3 and #4.to a uniform grade. The grade of the bottom of the channel shall not be changed except as made necessary by the material obtained from the channel bottom. Deviations may be permitted so long as the grade constructed is free from sharp breaks, dips, and ridges and will provide a uniform slope.

The bottom width of the channels shall be maintained as wide as practicable to still achieve stable side slopes. Side slopes may be somewhat variable to aid balancing the earthwork, but no slope shall be steeper than that needed to be stable.

Should there develop any depressions where the material obtained from shaping the channel bottom is insufficient to construct a smooth slope, additional material shall be obtained from the slopes as directed by the Engineer and placed in the bottom of the channel.

All existing drainage structures to be retained shall be cleaned. Inlet ditches shall be cleaned within the limits of the main channel as required by the Engineer for proper drainage from the tributaries.

100.03 Method of Measurement. Shaping existing channel will be measured by the 100' survey station along the centerline of the channel. This measurement will be made to the nearest foot. 200 lb Rip Rap will be measured by the tonnage.

100.04 Basis of Payment. Work completed and accepted and measured as provided above will be paid for at the contract unit price bid per station for Shaping Existing Channel, which price shall be full compensation for removing and disposing of weeks and rubbish; for excavating and hauling of material; for grading and shaping the bottom of the channel; for cleaning existing drainage structures and inlet ditches; and for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, tools, and incidentals necessary to complete the work. Rip Rap will be paid for by tonnage based on tickets. (Projects #1 and #5 ONLY)


