This is a reimbursable program, which means once the sponsor receives an official Notice to Proceed from the AHTD, up to 80% of the costs directly attributable to the construction of the project can be reimbursed. The local sponsor is responsible for maintaining records and proving that expenses are legitimate and directly related to the project. This may be in the form of receipts, time sheets, etc.

**Please Note: A resolution from the Applicant's governing body is required to be submitted with the application. A draft resolution should have been downloaded with this application.

DEADLINE for this application is Monday, May 1, 2017 at 4:00pm (CDT). Applications received after the deadline will not be reviewed or eligible for funding.
